

RESOLUTION NO. _____

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT A WRITTEN REPORT TO THE BOARD DESCRIBING MIAMI-DADE COUNTY'S EFFORTS IN SUPPORT OF AUTISM-RELATED CAUSES OVER THE PRECEDING 10 YEARS, AND DESCRIBING ANY PLANNED FUTURE EVENTS OR EXPENDITURES IN SUPPORT OF AUTISM-RELATED CAUSES

WHEREAS, autism and autism spectrum disorder are general terms that are used to describe brain developmental disorders that are characterized, in varying degrees, by difficulties in social interaction, verbal and nonverbal communication, and repetitive behaviors; and

WHEREAS, according to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, approximately 1 in 68 American children are on the autism spectrum—a statistic that represents a ten-fold increase in prevalence over the last 40 years; and

WHEREAS, in addition to its effect on children, autism impacts over 3 million persons in the United States and tens of millions of people around the world—statistics which are also on the rise at rates between 10 to 17 percent; and

WHEREAS, in order to stem the rising tide of autism, both in the United States and around the world, additional funding is necessary—not only to improve the quality of medical care that is provided to those who live with autism, but also to provide for the education and vocational training of those same persons; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County has shown itself to be a strong supporter of causes that assist those who live with autism, such as by annually hosting the Miami International Agriculture, Horse and Cattle Show, which benefits the South Florida Autism Charter School;

enacting legislation in support of the wallet card, which will help facilitate better communication between persons with autism spectrum disorder and law enforcement officers and first responders (Resolution R-1112-15); urging Congress and the Florida legislature to increase funding for autism spectrum disorder research (Resolution R-238-15); and providing in-kind support for various events in support of autism-related causes; and

WHEREAS, in order to document its past efforts with respect to autism, and in order to identify potential opportunities for additional support of autism-related causes, this Board desires to direct the County Mayor or designee to prepare a report identifying all of the County's efforts in support of autism-related causes over the preceding 10 years, and the report shall also include any planned future events or expenditures in support of autism-related causes,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Mayor or designee is directed to prepare a written report to the Board describing all of the County's efforts in support of autism-related causes over the preceding 10 years, and describing any planned future events or expenditures in support of autism-related causes. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee shall provide the report to this Board within 90 days of the effective date of this resolution and shall place the completed report on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
