Subject: Contract Award Recommendation in the Amount of \$227,805.74 to Highway Striping, Inc. for the People's Transportation Plan Project Entitled Push-Button Contract for Pavement Markings Installation (North); and Authorizing the Use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds for Such Purposes

Recommendation

The attached Contract Award Recommendation for the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) project entitled *Push-Button Contract for Pavement Markings Installation (North)* (Project MCC 7040 Plan - CICC 7040-0/07 Request for Price Quotation (RPQ) No. 20150101) in the amount of \$227,805.74 to Highway Striping, Inc., was prepared by the Public Works and Waste Management Department (PWWM) and is recommended for approval by the Board of County Commissioners (Board).

This Contract Award Recommendation is placed for Committee review pursuant to Miami-Dade County (County) Code Section 29-124(f). This Contract Award Recommendation may only be considered by the Board if the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has forwarded a recommendation to the Board prior to the date scheduled for Board consideration or 45 days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this contract award recommendation. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and 45 days have not elapsed since the filing of this award recommendation, I will request a withdrawal of this item.

Scope

The work to be performed under this contract includes pavement markings and signage for existing and new streets and bike lanes at designated sites within the County maintenance road system. There are no specific sites identified for this project. The locations of work for this project will be located inside the boundary area of the north portions of the County down to SW 8 Street.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact will be approximately \$227,805.74 and will be funded from the Charter County Transportation Surtax. This figure includes the base contract amount of \$199,214.76 and contingency and dedicated allowance amounts. There is no fiscal impact to operations or maintenance.

The proposed improvements qualify under the allowable work categories included in the PTP Neighborhood Improvements Section. The funding index code for this Project is CPEPTP00PAVM (Fiscal Year 2015-16 Adopted Capital Budget Project No. 606910).

Delegation of Authority

No additional authority is being requested within the body of this contract.

Track Record/Monitor

Highway Striping, Inc. is performing work for PWWM at a satisfactory level. The Capital Improvements Information System (CIIS) database lists 12 awarded construction contracts from each of the following departments:

- one (1) from Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces, and
- 11 from PWWM.

The referenced database also lists a total of 14 contractor performance evaluations (several contracts having two (2) evaluations on file, an interim, and a project closeout) with an overall performance rating of 3.7 (satisfactory performance) out of a possible 4.0 (superior performance) rating. The CIIS and information relevant to this contractor's performance is available through the Internal Services Department (ISD). ISD's History of Violations report lists no violations for this contractor.

According to the Florida Department of State's Division of Corporations, Highway Striping, Inc., Company Principal is Julio C. Nieto and the company's address is listed as 10724 SW 188 Street, Miami, Florida, 33157.

Following PWWM's standard operating procedures, a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled after award of this contract. The person responsible for all PTP projects in PWWM is Alejandro Martinez-Esteve, RA, LEED AP, Manager of the Capital Improvements Section. Following completion of the award process, the project will be assigned to Joaquin Rabassa, Project Coordinator, for the day-to-day responsibilities.

Background

As part of the PTP Neighborhood Improvements initiative, PWWM continues to take advantage of various contracting mechanisms such as the Miscellaneous Construction Contracting process available under the MCC 7040 Program. Through this process, PWWM forwards a Request for Price Quotation, by way of facsimile transmission, to a pool of pre-qualified Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) contractors for the respective trade. Additionally, all solicitations are available online through the County portal under the "Procurement Solicitations" link. The project's award evaluation is based upon the bid submitted by the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for the project.

PWWM staff determined that the scope of work for this project qualified for a CSBE set-aside (Levels I, II, and III). Per I.O. 3-37, a Community Workforce Program Goal is not applicable to this project as the contract value does not exceed \$250,000.00. On August 20, 2015, PWWM forwarded RPQ No. 20150101, utilizing the MCC 7040 Plan - CICC 7040-0/07 Contract, to a list of 53 pre-qualified firms. A total of two (2) firms purchased contract documents and the two (2) firms proffered a bid.


On September 25, 2015, Highway Striping, Inc. proffered the lowest responsive and responsible base bid of \$199,214.76, 31 percent above the County's cost estimate. The price utilized for the Engineering Cost estimate were the average of the prices in effect at the time the contract procurement was initiated. PWWM staff reviewed all bids received and concluded that the prices submitted reflect the current market price.

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Based on the result of the solicitation, PWWM issued a recommendation for award on October 15, 2015 for RPQ No. 20150101 to Highway Striping, Inc., with the stipulation that approval for this project must be obtained from the CITT and the Board. A copy of all bids and the bid tabulation for this project are available by contacting Alejandro Martinez-Esteve.

The work to be accomplished for this project consists of, but is not limited to, furnishing all supervision, labor, required materials, equipment, and tools to provide pavement markings and signage improvements. The work includes marking and remarking of existing streets and bike lanes at designated sites within the County maintenance road system.


