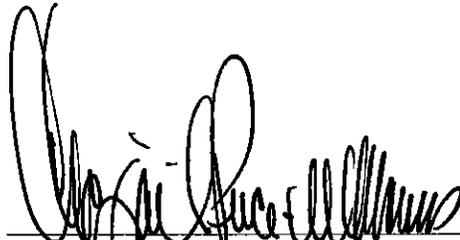

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PREPARE A FEASIBILITY STUDY REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A MOBILE APPLICATION BASED TICKETING SYSTEM FOR MIAMI-DADE TRANSIT AND DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO SUBMIT TO THE BOARD A REPORT REGARDING THE FEASIBILITY STUDY

WHEREAS, traffic congestion continues to be a significant problem in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, an increase in the usage of public transit would reduce traffic congestion and fuel consumption; and

WHEREAS, making the purchase of transit fare more convenient would increase the public's willingness to use public transit; and

WHEREAS, the use of a mobile application based ticketing system would allow transit patrons to purchase and display tickets on their smartphone; and

WHEREAS, the use of a mobile application based ticketing system would create a more efficient transit operation by reducing the time needed for the loading of passengers; and

WHEREAS, a mobile application based ticketing system would provide Miami-Dade Transit and its patrons with real-time, dynamic information; and

WHEREAS, mobile application base ticketing systems are currently in use for transit systems in New York, Chicago, Boston, and New Orleans; and

WHEREAS, developing a mobile application ticketing system for Miami-Dade Transit would make the overall transit system more user friendly,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to prepare a feasibility study regarding the implementation of a mobile application based ticketing system for Miami-Dade Transit. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee shall provide a report to this Board regarding the feasibility study and implementation plan within 90 days of the effective date of this resolution and shall place the completed report on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Barbara J. Jordan and the Co-Sponsor is Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz. It was offered by Commissioner , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

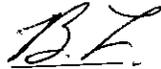
