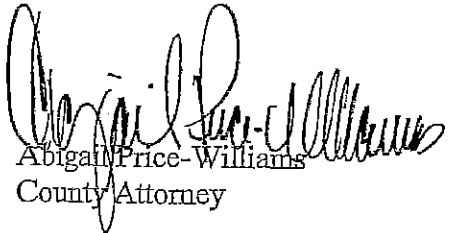

RESOLUTION RE-APPOINTING MR. ARTHUR MEYER TO  
THE MIAMI-DADE EXPRESSWAY AUTHORITY

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Arthur Meyer is a current member of the Miami-Dade Expressway Authority (Authority); and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Meyer was appointed as a member of the Authority by the Board of County Commissioners (Board) in March 2015 to fill a seat that had been vacated; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Meyer's term officially ended on February 7, 2016, however, members are allowed to holdover service until a new appointment or re-appointment is made, as authorized by Section 2-129 of the Code of Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Meyer only served as a member of the Authority for approximately eleven months and desires the opportunity to serve at least a full term; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Meyer is currently the Project Development Specialist at Balfour Beatty Construction charged with oversight of business development, business acquisitions and project solutions in South Florida with special emphasis in Miami-Dade County and formerly was the Project Development Manager for Facchina Construction of Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Meyer generously gives of his time to various civic and professional leadership activities including, but not limited to, his service as a founding board member for the State of Florida Council on Public Private Partnerships with a mission to promote the development of public assets using P3 delivery methods and the State of Florida Board of Governors which is the board responsible for mobilizing resources and diverse constituencies to govern and advance the State University System of Florida, as well as to support and advocate for high-quality teaching, research and public service; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Meyer's civic and professional leadership involvement also includes, but is not limited to, service on the Greater Miami Chamber of Commerce Real Estate Committee as the REAL Summit & Awards Chair leading a group of 20 real estate industry volunteers planning a summit, the Board of Directors of the Latin Builders Association, and the Major League Soccer Expansion Franchise Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with County Resolution No. R-71-98, persons appointed to the Authority are to possess outstanding reputations for integrity and responsibility; and

**WHEREAS**, additionally, in making such appointments, the Board may give due regard to, among other things, the interests of the environment, the non-vehicular and alternate transportation, mass transit, transportation, organized labor, and disabled communities, as well as the architecture, engineering and accounting professions, the convention and tourism industries, Miami-Dade County taxpayers, and the public-at-large; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Meyer is eminently qualified for re-appointment to the Authority, as evidenced by the attached resume; and

**WHEREAS**, re-appointing Mr. Meyer to the Authority will allow him to continue his service to the community and the Authority,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that the Board hereby re-appoints Arthur Meyer to the Miami-Dade Expressway Authority for a term of four years.
