Subject: Request for Additional Expenditure Authority to Prequalification Pool No. 9711-0/23, Pipe and Fittings for Water and Wastewater Services

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) authorize increased expenditure authority of \$19,000,000 to *Prequalification Pool No. 9711-0/23, Pipe and Fittings for Water and Wastewater Services*, for the Water and Sewer Department. This prequalification pool was originally approved by the Board on September 17, 2013 for a 10-year term. The pool provides the Water and Sewer Department with access to vendors for the purchase of pipes, valves and fittings for force mains and pump stations that are integral to the proper functioning of Miami-Dade County's water and wastewater plants.

This increase in allocation is being requested to facilitate the Consent Decree projects as mandated by the County's agreement with the United States Department of Justice and to support daily operations. The projects include infrastructure upgrades to force mains and pump stations, requiring the use of this pool to purchase materials.

Scope

The impact of this item is countywide in nature.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The contract expires on December 31, 2023 and has an existing allocation of \$28,500,000. The recommended modification will authorize additional expenditure authority of \$19,000,000 as set forth in the table below, increasing the total pool value to \$47,500,000.


