RESOLUTION DESIGNATING AS "FONTAINEBLEAU LAKES" THE AREA OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY THAT IS BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY STATE ROAD 836 (DOLPHIN EXPRESSWAY), ON THE SOUTH BY NORTHWEST 8TH STREET, ON THE EAST BY NORTHWEST 87TH AVENUE, AND ON THE WEST BY NORTHWEST 97TH AVENUE

WHEREAS, Fontainebleau Lakes is an area in northwestern Miami-Dade County that is bounded on the north by State Road 836 (Dolphin Expressway), on the south by Northwest 8th Street, on the east by Northwest 87th Avenue, and on the west by Northwest 97th Avenue; and

WHEREAS, although this area is adjacent to the Fontainebleau neighborhood, the residents of this area have their own unique identity and sense of community; and

WHEREAS, due to the number of gated residential enclaves and limited roadway access within the Fontainebleau neighborhood, the designation of the proposed area as Fontainebleau Lakes is necessary for wayfinding and public safety; and

WHEREAS, the property owners and residents of this area wish to have the community in which they live be identified and known throughout Miami-Dade County and beyond by the Fontainebleau Lakes name; and

WHEREAS, the evolution of the Fontainebleau Lakes area and community merits its official recognition and designation by Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, officially designating this area as "Fontainebleau Lakes" will help foster the community in that area, encouraging the further improvement and development of this area and thereby having a positive fiscal impact on Miami-Dade County's economy,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board having conducted a public hearing, designates as “Fontainebleau Lakes” an area in northwestern Miami-Dade County that is bounded on the north by State Road 836 (Dolphin Expressway), on the south by Northwest 8th Street, on the east by Northwest 87th Avenue, and on the west by Northwest 97th Avenue.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Sen. Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
