





ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO FIRST SOURCE HIRING REFERRAL PROGRAM; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 12-32, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 14-33, TO REMOVE THE SUNSET PROVISION FOR FIRST SOURCE HIRING REFERRAL PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

**WHEREAS**, the Board enacted the First Source Hiring Referral Program, codified at Section 2-2113 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, with a two year sunset provision; and

**WHEREAS**, the First Source Hiring Referral Program (the "Program") was to be a pilot program which applied to County contracts for goods and services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board passed and adopted Ordinance No. 14-33 which amended Ordinance No. 12-32 by extending the sunset date for the Program for an additional two years; and

**WHEREAS**, the County awards millions of dollars in contracts for goods and services each year, which results in the creation of a wide variety of employment opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, the First Source Hiring Referral Program serves as a first source job registry and referral program for employment created from or through County goods and services contracts, and the Program should continue without a sunset provision,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1.** The sunset provision contained in Section 6 of Ordinance No. 12-32, as amended by Ordinance No. 14-33, is hereby amended as follows:<sup>1</sup>

~~[[Section 6. This ordinance shall sunset in four (4) years from the effective date, unless extended by this Board.]]~~

**Section 2.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

**Section 3.** It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance, including any sunset provision, shall become and be made a part of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate word.

**Section 4.** This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an override by this Board.
