

RESOLUTION WAIVING, BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT, THE TERM LIMIT IMPOSED ON ARTHUR FERNANDEZ AND REAPPOINTING HIM TO THE CONSTRUCTION TRADES QUALIFYING BOARD FOR ANOTHER TERM

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 2-11.38.2 of the Code of Miami-Dade County (“the Code”), no board member shall serve more than eight consecutive years on any one board unless the Board of County Commissioners, by a two-thirds vote of the members present, votes to waive the term limit; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 10-20 of the Code, members of the Construction Trades Qualifying Board serve three year terms; and

**WHEREAS**, Arthur Fernandez, a licensed electrical contractor, has reached his term limit on the Construction Trades Qualifying Board; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board wishes to waive the applicable term limit and reappoint Mr. Fernandez to the Construction Trades Qualifying Board, “B” Division, for another term,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board, by a two-thirds vote of Board members present, waives the eight-year term limit restriction for Arthur Fernandez and reappoints him to another term on the Construction Trades Qualifying Board, “B” Division.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz. It was offered by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


