



RESOLUTION WAIVING, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-11.38.2 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AND BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT, THE TERM LIMIT IMPOSED ON LIVING WAGE COMMISSION MEMBER ARTHUR J. ROSENBERG

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-8.9 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, term duration for members of the Living Wage Commission is two years; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 2-11.38.2 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, which governs the Living Wage Commission with respect to term limits, no board member shall serve for more than eight consecutive years on a board unless waived by a two-thirds vote of the members present of this Board; and

WHEREAS, Arthur J. Rosenberg, who has served with distinction as a member of the Living Wage Commission, has reached his term limit; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Rosenberg's continued service as a member would ensure the effective operation of the Living Wage Commission; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to waive the applicable term limit and reappoint Mr. Rosenberg to the Living Wage Commission for another two year term,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board waives, pursuant to Section 2-11.38.2 of the Code of Miami-Dade County and by a two-thirds vote of Board members present, the term limits imposed on Arthur J. Rosenberg and hereby reappoints him to another two year term on the Living Wage Commission.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
