

Resolution No. R-636-14, adopted on July 1, 2014, requires that the Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) complete a background research on applicants being considered to serve on County Boards and Trusts that require nominations and/or appointments by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC).

In accordance with that Resolution, we are providing this report as a supplement to the BCC Agenda Item 8(L)1.

Pursuant to R-636-14, the OCA completed background research regarding BCC Agenda Item 8(L)1, Resolution to appoint Mr. Arturo Lopez as a member of the Agricultural Practices Advisory Board for a term of four years and there were no relevant findings that came to our attention. *However, according to the Miami-Dade County Clerk of Courts Public Records Search, the search returned more records than the allowable limit, and our review was based on a random selection of 500 records and only a subset of the entire result.*
