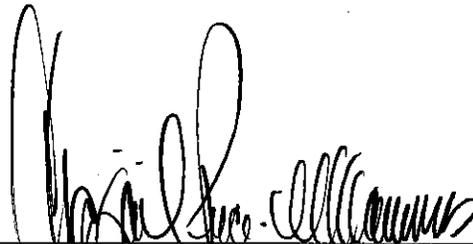

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF SW  
122ND AVENUE BETWEEN SW 105TH STREET AND SW  
105TH TERRACE AS "CHERYL SMITH WAY"

**WHEREAS**, for over 31 years, Cheryl Smith, as a registrar at the Devon Aire K-8 Center in Miami, Florida, was the smiling, comforting face that first greeted new families and students to the school; and

**WHEREAS**, fluent in both English and Spanish, Cheryl demonstrated an outstanding work ethic, knowledge and attention to detail that helped the Devon Aire K-8 Center run smoothly and effectively year after year; and

**WHEREAS**, Cheryl was also a dedicated wife, mother, and grandmother, as well as a loyal friend and coworker whose warmth and witty sense of humor brightened the day of anyone who had the pleasure to meet her; and

**WHEREAS**, in early June 2015, Cheryl was diagnosed with liver cancer, yet despite her diagnosis, she continued to come into work and serve the Devon Aire community every day; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 23, 2015, Cheryl lost her battle with cancer and passed away; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would like to honor the memory of Cheryl Smith and her dedicated service to the Devon Aire community by codesignating the street in front of the Devon Aire K-8 Center—that portion of SW 122nd Avenue between SW 105th Street and SW 105th Terrace—as "Cheryl Smith Way"; and

**WHEREAS**, that portion of SW 122nd Avenue between SW 105th Street and SW 105th Terrace is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 8,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates that portion of SW 122nd Avenue between SW 105th Street and SW 105th Terrace as “Cheryl Smith Way”.

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Miami-Dade Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade County Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Daniella Levine Cava. It was offered by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
