



We would like to introduce you to one of the most successful sports programs in Miami Dade County, with over 7 CONSECUTIVE State Championships (10 in the past 11 years and 13 overall, with 6 state runner-up titles). This program exists in the inner city core, amongst the most impoverished and violent areas in Miami Dade County.

The Miami Northwestern Senior High School Track and Field Program continues to strive and expose our athletes to the opportunities that Track/Field has to offer. Our athletes consistently rank among the top in the Nation and are invited to compete at various National Championship meets each season. It is important for financial contributors to continue supporting this program as a positive experience for our youth in this community and throughout the state of Florida.

The Louie Bing Track Meet (named after one of our esteemed coaches) has existed for 31 years here in Miami Dade County, serving countless athletes throughout Florida. This yearly event is a positive event for this community and is the major fundraiser for our men and women's track program. Sadly, each year I am faced with the task of securing financial backing to produce and operate the track program. One of our yearly goals is to find a permanent major sponsor, so that this event can continue to provide an outlet for our student athletes and the community. Last year, this event had over 52 men and 48 women track teams, plus teams from the Caribbean in competition.

In order to try and meet the continuing needs of our program, we rely totally on the generosity of individuals and organizations for support. We are hopeful that your office will be able to be a contributor to this event and experience firsthand the pride we take in supporting our youth and representing our community.

The Louie Bing Track meet is normally held at Trax Powell stadium. However, due to its deplorable condition, the event is being held at Miami Dade County's Tropical Park. The park has a restriction on any outside concessions being performed. This is a major setback for us, as we rely on funds raised from the concession funds for continuing our program. We are hopeful for any assistance in areas such as the stadium rental, security (police), purchase of awards/trophies, etc. We are available to meet with you at your convenience.

The Louie Bing Track meet is scheduled for February 19th thru the 20th, 2016.
