



RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE PARKS, RECREATION AND OPEN SPACES DEPARTMENT FOR THE MARCH 12 AND MARCH 13, 2016 "WEST END ART FAIR" EVENT SPONSORED BY COMMISSIONER JUAN C. ZAPATA IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,293.70 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 11 FY 2015-16 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, Commissioner Juan C. Zapata has requested in-kind services from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the March 12 and March 13, 2016 "West End Art Fair" event in an amount not to exceed \$5,293.70; and

WHEREAS, the "West End Art Fair" is a family-friendly event which features dozens of local artists, craftsmen and food vendors from the West End; and

WHEREAS, the "West End Art Fair" event is a district event, as that term is defined in the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$5,293.70 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the balance of the District 11 FY 2015-16 In-Kind Reserve funds,

Second annual West End Art Fair to feature arts, crafts and more

MIAMI-DADE – Arts, crafts and family-friendly fun are coming to the West End this weekend as the West End Art Fair returns for its second year.

The fair will take place on Saturday, March 12 and Sunday, March 13 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. (both days) along Southwest 158th Avenue from south of Southwest 88th Street to just north of Southwest 96th Street.

The event will feature dozens of local artists, craftsmen and food vendors from around the West End and the county. Children will have the opportunity to compete for prizes in four Bricks 4 Kids LEGO-building contests, which will take place at 11 a.m. and 4 p.m. both days. Art lovers who take their bike to the fair can join Pérez Art Museum Miami guides on bike tours of three PAMM outdoor art exhibits at nearby Kendale Lakes Library, Olympic Park and Hammocks Community Park as part of the Inside|Out project, which is bringing reproductions of artworks from the museum's collection to select public parks. The bike tours will take place at 2 p.m. both days.

"The West End is really becoming known as a vibrant center of culture, and this art fair is another great opportunity to celebrate that," said Miami-Dade County Commissioner Juan C. Zapata, who represents the West End.
