



RESOLUTION NO. _____

RESOLUTION URGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE TO ENACT LEGISLATION THAT WOULD REVISE ITS CODESIGNATION OF NE 73RD STREET BETWEEN NE 2ND AVENUE AND NE 3RD COURT FROM BEING “REVEREND WILNER MAXI STREET” TO BEING “REVEREND WILNER MAXY STREET”; AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-622-15 TO APPROVE SUCH REVISION

WHEREAS, during the 2014 legislative session, Chapter 2014–228, Laws of Florida (Senate Bill 820), was enacted which, among other codesignations, codesignated NE 73rd Street between NE 2nd Avenue and NE 3rd Court as “Reverend Wilner Maxi Street”; and

WHEREAS, on July 14, 2015, this Board adopted Resolution No. R-622-15, which approved the Florida Legislature’s codesignation of NE 73rd Street between NE 2nd Avenue and NE 3rd Court as “Reverend Wilner Maxi Street”, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, on July 14, 2016, the Miami City Commission also passed a resolution supporting the Florida Legislature’s codesignation of NE 73rd Street between NE 2nd Avenue and NE 3rd Court as “Reverend Wilner Maxi Street”, which resolution is currently pending review by the City of Miami Mayor; and

WHEREAS, it has come to this Board’s attention that Reverend Wilner Maxy’s last name is in fact spelled “Maxy” as opposed to “Maxi”; and

WHEREAS, this Board would therefore like to urge the Florida Legislature to revise its codesignation of NE 73rd Street between NE 2nd Avenue and NE 3rd Court from being “Reverend Wilner Maxi Street” to being “Reverend Wilner Maxy Street”; and

WHEREAS, NE 73rd Street between NE 2nd Avenue and NE 3rd Court is a city road located within the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 3,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges the Florida Legislature to enact legislation that would revise the Florida Legislature's codesignation of NE 73rd Street between NE 2nd Avenue and NE 3rd Court from being "Reverend Wilner Maxi Street" to being "Reverend Wilner Maxy Street".

Section 2. Amends Resolution No. R-622-15 to approve the revision of the Florida Legislature's codesignation of NE 73rd Street between NE 2nd Avenue and NE 3rd Court from being "Reverend Wilner Maxi Street" to being "Reverend Wilner Maxy Street", subject to the Florida Legislature revising such codesignation to "Reverend Wilner Maxy Street". This amendment shall become effective on the effective date of the state legislation revising such codesignation as set forth herein.

Section 3. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the Governor, Senate President, House Speaker, the Chair and Members of the Miami-Dade State Legislative Delegation, the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Miami, the Secretary of the Florida Department of Transportation, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Miami-Dade Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the City of Miami Police Department and the City of Miami Fire-Rescue Department.

Section 4. Directs the County's state lobbyists to advocate for the legislation set forth in Section 1 above, and authorizes and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to include this item in the 2017 State Legislative Package when it is presented to the Board.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Chairman Jean Monestime. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:





RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE'S
CODESIGNATION OF NE 73RD STREET BETWEEN NE 2ND
AVENUE AND NE 3RD COURT AS "REVEREND WILNER
MAXI STREET"

WHEREAS, during the 2014 legislative session, Chapter 2014-228, Laws of Florida (Senate Bill 820), was enacted which, among other codesignations, codesignated NE 73rd Street between NE 2nd Avenue and NE 3rd Court as "Reverend Wilner Maxi Street"; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Wilner Maxi was born on April 1, 1936 in Haiti and migrated to the United States in 1970; and

WHEREAS, in 1973, Reverend Maxi helped found Haitian Emmanuel Baptist Church in Miami, and in 1983 he became Senior Pastor of the church; and

WHEREAS, during his ministry, Reverend Maxi has worked tirelessly to make a lasting difference in the lives of the members of his church and the community, through his educational and religious work as well as his service on numerous community boards; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Maxi was also awarded the key to the City of Miami for his exemplary service to the community; and

WHEREAS, Haitian Emmanuel Baptist Church is located at 7321 NE 2nd Avenue in the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, section 334.071, Florida Statutes, provides that the installation of state road designation signs shall be contingent on the applicable county or city commission passing a resolution in support of the particular honorary road designation; and

WHEREAS, NE 73rd Street between NE 2nd Avenue and NE 3rd Court is a city road located within the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, before the Florida Department of Transportation will install signs reflecting the "Reverend Wilner Maxi Street" road designation, Miami-Dade County is required to pass a resolution in support of this road designation; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to approve the "Reverend Wilner Maxi Street" road designation; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 3,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the Florida Legislature's codesignation of NE 73rd Street between NE 2nd Avenue and NE 3rd Court as "Reverend Wilner Maxi Street".

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this resolution to the Secretary of the Florida Department of Transportation, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the City of Miami Police Department and the City of Miami Fire-Rescue Department.
