

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF SW
43RD TERRACE BETWEEN SW 87TH AVENUE AND SW
89TH AVENUE AS "BERNARDO SOTO WAY"

WHEREAS, Bernardo Soto was a loving husband and father, as well as a church community leader, whose warmth lifted everyone around him; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Soto selflessly dedicated himself to his family, friends, and church community, leading service groups and participating as a volunteer for church retreats, Encuentros Familiares, focused on improving family life; and

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2013, Mr. Soto passed away; and

WHEREAS, to honor the memory of Mr. Soto and his contributions to the community, this Board would like to codesignate SW 43rd Terrace between SW 87th Avenue and SW 89th Avenue as "Bernardo Soto Way"; and

WHEREAS, that portion of SW 43rd Terrace between SW 87th Avenue and SW 89th Avenue is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at public hearing, codesignates SW 43rd Terrace between SW 87th Avenue and SW 89th Avenue as "Bernardo Soto Way".

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Miami-Dade Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade County Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


