

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING A CASH ALLOCATION FOR THE MAY 18, 2016 “RIDE OF SILENCE – MIAMI” EVENT SPONSORED BY E B C 2, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$500.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 7 FY 2015-16 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, E B C 2, Inc. has requested in-kind services through a cash allocation for the May 18, 2016 “Ride of Silence - Miami” event in an amount not to exceed \$500.00; and

WHEREAS, the “Ride of Silence - Miami” event raises awareness of bicycle safety, educates the public on the rights of cyclists using the roadway, and honors cyclists who have perished or been injured while cycling; and

WHEREAS, E B C 2, Inc., is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the “Ride of Silence - Miami” event is a small event, as that term is defined in the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$500.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the balance of the District 7 FY 2015-16 In-Kind Reserve funds,


