

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO STUDY THE CREATION OF A MIAMI-DADE COUNTY RADIO BROADCASTING SERVICE TO PROVIDE INFORMATION TO THE PEOPLE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY REGARDING, AMONG OTHER THINGS, LEGISLATION AND SERVICES THAT AFFECT THE CITIZENS OF THE COUNTY AND DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR TO PRESENT A REPORT TO THE BOARD CONTAINING A PROPOSAL TO CREATE SUCH SERVICE OR OTHER APPROPRIATE RECOMMENDATION

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade TV televises a 24 hours a day, seven days a week government programming network carried by all cable TV systems in Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade TV televises live coverage of meetings of the Board of County Commissioners and its committees, as well as provides residents with a wide variety of informational and educational programming about government programs and services, public safety, arts, culture, emergency services and the environment; and

**WHEREAS**, the creation of a similar County radio station as an extension of Miami-Dade TV could result in the transmission of County meetings and provide news and important County information to a broader number of Miami-Dade County residents who may not have access to a television; and

**WHEREAS**, the creation of a Miami-Dade County radio broadcasting service would require the County to obtain a radio broadcasting license from the Federal Communications Commission and construct radio broadcast facilities or contract with a third party to provide such operations; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to study the best method of establishing a County radio station, the costs associated with establishing a radio station and the benefits a radio station will bring to the community,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

**Section 1.** The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee is directed to study the creation of a Miami-Dade County radio station including: (1) the best method of creating a County radio broadcasting service to provide information to the people of Miami-Dade County regarding, among other things, legislation and services; (2) whether it is more beneficial to own a radio broadcasting license or use a third-party license and facilities; (3) the costs of establishing and operating a County radio broadcasting station; and (4) the benefits of operating a County radio broadcasting station.

**Section 2.** The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee shall provide a report to this Board detailing the results of such study and shall recommend either a proposal to establish a County radio broadcast station or other such appropriate recommendations not later than 120 days following the effective date of this resolution. The completed report and recommendations shall be placed on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.
