

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PREPARE AN IMPLEMENTATION PLAN TO PROVIDE CHARTER TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AND PUBLIC HEALTH TRUST EMPLOYEES COMMUTING FROM WEST MIAMI-DADE COUNTY TO THE DADELAND NORTH METRORAIL STATION AND PRESENT SAID PLAN TO THE COUNTY COMMISSION PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 14-65

WHEREAS, traffic congestion continues to be a significant problem in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the west end area of Miami-Dade County ("West End"), especially during morning and afternoon rush hour periods, is among the most congested areas of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, many residents in the West End area, including many Miami-Dade County and Public Health Trust employees, commute to and from the Downtown Miami and Civic Center areas; and

WHEREAS, providing safe and reliable charter transportation service between the West End area and the Dadeland North Metrorail Station would provide much needed transportation alternatives to Miami-Dade County commuters and promote the use of public transportation; and

WHEREAS, many Miami-Dade County and Jackson Health employees commute to Downtown Miami or Civic Center from the West End via Metrobus and the Dadeland North Metrorail Station; and

WHEREAS, creating a charter transportation service running from at or near the Metrobus Park and Ride facilities located at 9155 SW 162 Avenue and 14955 SW 88 Street to the Dadeland North Metrorail Station during peak weekday commuting hours would reduce congestion,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to prepare an implementation plan to provide direct charter transportation services for Miami-Dade County and Public Health Trust employees commuting from West Miami-Dade County to the Dadeland North Metrorail Station. Said implementation plan shall analyze potential operators, proposed hours of operation, and a mechanism for Miami-Dade County and Public Health Trust employees to make advanced reservations for said direct charter transportation services.

Section 2. Directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to provide the requested implementation plan to the Board within 90 days of the effective date of this resolution, which shall be placed on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Juan C. Zapata. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
