Subject: Passing of Dr. Bruce Hyma, Miami-Dade Medical Examiner – Interim Appointment

After a three year battle with cancer, I am saddened to announce the passing of Dr. Bruce Hyma, Medical Examiner, on April 17, 2016.

For over 15 years, Dr. Hyma led the state's largest and busiest Medical Examiner District. Concurrent with his duties as Miami-Dade's Medical Examiner, he served as Chairman of the State Medical Examiners Commission and held a volunteer faculty appointment as Assistant Clinical Professor of Pathology at the University of Miami, Miller School of Medicine. His influence on the forensic pathology profession was immense. He oversaw over 30,000 autopsies, including some of South Florida's most high profile cases. A compassionate humanitarian, he also directed a Miami-Dade Cemetery beautification project that provided a proper resting ground and place of tribute for our Miami-Dade County residents.

I want to extend my deepest sympathy to the Hyma family- his wife, Janet, his three children and two grandchildren- and the entire Medical Examiner department during this time of bereavement.

Pursuant to the authority vested in me under the provision of Section 2.02-C of the Miami-Dade County Home Rule Charter, I hereby appoint Dr. Emma O. Lew to the position of Interim Director of the Miami-Dade County Medical Examiner Department. Dr. Emma Lew has dedicated the past 25 years to the Forensic Pathology profession. She joined the Miami-Dade Medical Examiner Department as an Associate Medical Examiner in 1992 and was promoted to Deputy Chief Medical Examiner in 2001. As Deputy Chief, Dr. Lew provided sound leadership to the department and sage counsel to the Chief Medical Examiner. She ensured that the department maintained its strict National Association of Medical Examiners' Accreditation standards and managed a robust training program that prepared over 100 visiting physicians, Forensic Pathology Fellows, and Associate Medical Examiners for senior forensic pathologist positions throughout the world.

I am confident that Dr. Lew will lead the Medical Examiner Department in a manner that will maintain its reputation as a world-renowned forensic pathology facility.

- Maintains communications with other County agencies, State Attorney's Office, Public Defender's Office, U.S. Attorney's Office, law enforcement agencies and the general public. Testifies as an expert witness in criminal and civil proceedings.
- Assists in formulating departmental position with regard to legislative issues and works with County staff as required.
- Performs related work as required.
