



RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO COORDINATE WITH FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT TO INSTALL DOUBLE LIGHTING ON POLES OWNED BY FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT ALONG SW 157TH AVENUE AND TO IDENTIFY FUNDING SOURCES FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SAID DOUBLE LIGHTING

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County is responsible for the maintenance of SW 157<sup>th</sup> Avenue as a County Road; and

**WHEREAS**, Florida Power & Light (FPL) is a utility corporation with electrical power line poles in the public right of way along SW 157<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Bird Road and SW 59<sup>th</sup> Terrace; and

**WHEREAS**, the Miami-Dade County Department of Transportation and Public Works has installed bicycle paths along the SW 157<sup>th</sup> Avenue public right of way for transportation purposes and the benefit of the public; and

**WHEREAS**, the SW 157<sup>th</sup> Avenue roadway is currently illuminated by poles operated by FPL; and

**WHEREAS**, lighting along both the bicycle path and the public right of way will enhance the general public safety and welfare of the citizens of Miami-Dade County,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA,** this Board incorporates and adopts the foregoing recitals, directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to coordinate with FPL to install double lighting to pre-existing poles along SW 157<sup>th</sup> Avenue to sufficiently illuminate both the public right of way and bicycle paths, and directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to identify funding sources for the costs of installing and maintaining said double lighting.
