Ordinance Amending the Biscayne Beach Security Guard Special Taxing District

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve a petition submitted in accordance with Article 1, Chapter 18 of the Code of Miami-Dade County (Code) to amend Ordinance No. 89-126 (Ordinance), which created the Biscayne Beach Security Guard Special Taxing District (Special Taxing District). Implementation of this amending ordinance is contingent upon subsequent ratification through mailed ballot referendum by a majority vote of the qualified electors within the Special Taxing District's boundaries.

Scope

This Special Taxing District lies within District 4, represented by Commissioner Sally A. Heyman, and will upgrade the Special Taxing District's services to furnish, install, operate, and maintain video surveillance system, including recording devices, at the guardhouse.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

Amendment of this Special Taxing District's Ordinance will result in no economic impact on the Miami-Dade County (County) budget.

The economic impact on the private sector will be a perpetual annual special assessment for the upgraded service costs to all property owners within the Special Taxing District. If this amendment is approved, additional annual costs estimated to be \$409.22 per unit of assessment for the first year and \$2.00 per unit the second year will be collected to provide the video surveillance services. The succeeding years' costs will be determined on an annual basis. In addition to the annual security guard service costs for the Special Taxing District, the installation, operation, and maintenance costs of the video surveillance system will be included in the Special Taxing District's annual operating budget and will be collected in each of the Special Taxing District's property owner's annual combined Real Property tax bill once video surveillance services are provided. These additional costs are expected to occur in the 2018-19 fiscal year.

At this time, there will be no increase or decrease in County staffing due to the upgrade of this Special Taxing District. The private sector, which includes the security guard service provider, may increase its staffing levels to provide the service requirements created by this Special Taxing District.

Social Equity Statement

The proposed ordinance amends a special taxing district, pursuant to Article I, Section 1.01(A)(11) of the Miami-Dade County Home Rule Charter and Chapter 18 of the Code.

If approved, property owners within the Special Taxing District will pay additional special assessments appropriately apportioned according to the special benefit they receive from the Special Taxing District's upgraded services regardless of their demographics, and the total estimated amount of the additional special assessments to be levied would not be in excess of such special benefit. The amending petition, which was duly signed by more than 50 percent of the resident property owners, as required by Code, will upgrade the Special Taxing District's services to include a video surveillance system.

Pursuant to Section 18-20.2(b) of the Code regarding notice to purchasers of new residential property, it shall be the obligation of a seller of new residential property to provide the purchaser thereof with notice either of the existence of a special taxing district created pursuant to this Chapter of the Code or of a pending petition to create such a special taxing district. The notice required by this Section shall be set forth in the contract for sale and purchase of the new residential property.

Recommendation Concerning the Desirability of this District

The need for enhanced security guard service in the County is apparent. Residents and property owners of the County continue to demonstrate their desire for security guard service through numerous petitions and personal requests. The ability of the affected properties to pay special assessments is evident since the costs of Special Taxing District's services, including any bonds then outstanding, do not exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the assessed valuation of all properties within the Special Taxing District's boundaries (including homesteads) as shown by the last preceding assessment roll of the County. The video surveillance installed pursuant to the amendment of this Special Taxing District will provide special benefits to properties within the Special Taxing District's boundaries equal to or greater than the amount of special assessments to be levied. Furthermore, the proposed upgrade conforms to and in no way conflicts with the master plan of development for Miami-Dade County.

Track Record/Monitor

The Special Taxing District is managed by the County's Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department (PROS) and overseen by the Chief of the Special Taxing Districts Division (Division), Michael R. Bauman.

Background

The Biscayne Beach Security Guard Special Taxing District was created by Ordinance No. 89-126 on December 5, 1989, and subsequently ratified on January 16, 1990, by qualified electors residing within the Special Taxing District's boundaries through a special election by mailed ballot.

This Ordinance originally provided for a visible safety and sentinel security program initially to consist of one unarmed uniformed security guard operating from a guardhouse. Service is

provided 24 hours per day, 365 days a year. The proposed amendment to Ordinance No. 89-126 modifies the scope of service for the Special Taxing District to furnish, install, operate, and maintain high definition, infrared security cameras with electronic recording and storage devices, and appurtenances on every vehicular lane adjacent to the guardhouse to record the auto tags and a portion of the front of all vehicles entering and exiting the Special Taxing District. This amendment is subject to approval by the Special Taxing District's electors wherein every qualified registered voter residing within the Special Taxing District's boundaries will be afforded the opportunity to vote at an election to be conducted by mail and estimated to be held on May 19, 2017. If approved at election, installation and services will commence at the earliest practicable time.

In compliance with the provisions of Section 18-3 (c) of the Code, I recommend that this amendment be adopted, if approved by referendum subsequent to this public hearing.

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 89-126 RELATING TO THE BISCAYNE BEACH SECURITY GUARD SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, LOCATED ON STILLWATER DRIVE, GENERALLY BOUNDED BY BISCAYNE BAY ON THE NORTH, WEST, AND SOUTH, AND HAWTHORNE AVENUE ON THE EAST; ADDING VIDEO SURVEILLANCE AND RECORDING DEVICES AT THE GUARDHOUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN ELECTION; AND PROVIDING FOR EXCLUSION FROM THE CODE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on December 5, 1989, this Board passed Ordinance No. 89-126, creating the BISCAYNE BEACH SECURITY GUARD SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT ("Special Taxing District"); and

WHEREAS, on January 16, 1990, the Special Taxing District was approved by a majority vote of qualified electors residing within the Special Taxing District; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 18 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida ("Code"), a petition to amend Ordinance No. 89-126 to allow the installation of cameras and recording equipment at the Special Taxing District's guardhouse, duly signed by more than 50 percent of the resident owners of property within the Special Taxing District, was filed with the Clerk of the Board ("Clerk"); and

WHEREAS, upon receipt of such petition the Clerk transmitted a copy thereof to the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee who examined it and filed with the Clerk a memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated in this Ordinance by reference, setting forth the background of the Special Taxing District, an estimate of the cost of the improvement(s) and/or services to be provided, the need for and desirability of the Special Taxing District, the ability of the affected properties to bear the special assessments, certifying that the improvement(s) and/or services to be provided conform to the master plan of Miami-Dade County, and recommending that the Special Taxing District be amended; and

WHEREAS, the memorandum of the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee recommends amending the improvement(s) and/or services to be provided to the Special Taxing District to provide an additional special benefit to all property within the proposed district; and

WHEREAS, it appears to this Board from such memorandum that the improvement(s) and/or services petitioned for would be of special benefit to all property within the proposed district and that the total amount of the special assessments to be levied would not be in excess of such benefit; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk will certify the place, date, and hour for a public hearing on the petition of the property owners and the memorandum at which all interested persons will be afforded the opportunity to present for this Board's consideration their objections, if any, to the amendment of the improvement(s) and/or services to be provided to the Special Taxing District; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was held during the meeting of this Board on Tuesday,

, beginning at 9:30 a.m. in the Commission Chambers, Stephen P. Clark Center, 111 NW 1st Street, Miami, Florida.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. This Board incorporates the matters set forth in the foregoing recitals as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 89-126 is amended to allow the following additional improvements and/or services to be provided in the BISCAYNE BEACH SECURITY GUARD SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT:

Installation, operation, and maintenance of cameras with electronic recording and storage devices and appurtenances on every vehicular lane adjacent to the guardhouse to record the auto license plates and a portion of the front of all vehicles entering and exiting the Special Taxing District.

Section 3. The total expected costs of the installation and operation of these additional improvements and/or services, including engineering, administrative, billing, collecting, and processing is \$42,559.12 for the first year, and \$157.50 for the second year. The County will advance funds for this program, which sum shall be reimbursed by special assessments. The estimated additional cost to the property owners for these additional improvements and/or services is \$409.22 per unit the first year following the service upgrade, and \$2.00 per unit for the second year following the service upgrade. It is estimated that the total cost following the service upgrade per developed parcel of real property within the Special Taxing District for all improvements and/or services is \$2,624.73 for the first year following the service upgrade, and \$2,217.51 for the second year following the service upgrade. The additional upgraded operation and maintenance costs will be included in the Special Taxing District's annual operating budget. The succeeding years' assessments will be adjusted based on actual costs. The entire cost of the Special Taxing District's improvement(s) and services shall be specially assessed.

Section 4. It is hereby declared that said services will be a special benefit to all properties within the Special Taxing District and the total amount of special assessments to be levied as aforesaid will not be in excess of such special benefit.

Section 5. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee is directed to cause to be prepared and filed with the Clerk one revised Preliminary Assessment Roll for the improvements and/or services, in accordance with the provisions of Sections 18-14 and 18-22.1 of the Code. As authorized by Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, all special assessments levied and imposed under the provisions of this Ordinance shall be collected, subject to the provisions of Chapter 197, Florida Statutes, in the same manner and at the same time as ad valorem taxes. Unless paid when due, such assessments shall be deemed delinquent and payment thereof may be enforced by means of the procedures provided by the provisions of Chapter 197, Florida Statutes, and/or Section 18-14 of the Code, including possible loss of title.

Section 6. Except to amend the improvements and/or services to be provided in the BISCAYNE BEACH SECURITY GUARD SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT as provided herein, and to set forth estimated changes in assessments, this Ordinance does not affect, amend or modify Ordinance No. 89-126.

Section 7. A duly certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and recorded in the appropriate book of records.

Section 8. The provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect when approved by a majority vote of the qualified electors residing in the Special Taxing District at an election to be called by this Board and noticed and conducted as this Board shall determine by Resolution, and after

adoption of the revised assessment roll, unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become

effective only upon an override by this Board and an approval by a majority of those voting at the

election referred to herein.

Section 9. It is the intention of the Board, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of

this Ordinance be excluded from the Code.

<u>Proposed Public Improvement:</u> Furnish, install, operate, and maintain high definition, infrared security cameras with electronic recording and storage devices and appurtenances on every vehicular lane adjacent to the guardhouse to record the auto license plates, a portion of the front of all vehicles entering and exiting the District, and all pedestrians entering and exiting the District.

<u>District Boundary:</u> A portion of Section 3, Township 53 South, Range 42 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida; being more particularly described as follows:
