

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF MIAMI
CODESIGNATION OF S.W. 25TH AVENUE FROM S.W. 21ST
TERRACE TO S.W. 22ND STREET AS "AVENIDA JOSEFINA
P. CASTAÑO"

WHEREAS, after recommendation by the Miami Street Codesignation Review Committee, the Miami City Commission passed Resolution R-05-0512 on September 8, 2005, which codesignated that portion of Southwest 25th Avenue from Southwest 21st Terrace to Southwest 22nd Street as "Avenida Josefina P. Castaño" in memory of Josefina Castaño's work as a community leader who helped patients with end stage kidney failure; and

WHEREAS, a copy of Resolution R-05-0512 is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Josefina P. Castaño Kidney Foundation, a non-profit organization created in memory of Castaño, who passed away on September 19, 1999, provides assistance and relief to people suffering from severe kidney disease; and

WHEREAS, patients suffering from kidney disease may take part in the foundation's community center activities and find support among those who have shared the experience of undergoing dialysis treatment; and

WHEREAS, the foundation's community center also provides transportation and daily lunches to patients with kidney disease; and

WHEREAS, Southwest 25th Avenue from Southwest 21st Terrace to Southwest 22nd Street is a city road located in the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 5; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami would like for the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal mast arms; and

WHEREAS, this Board would also like to honor Josefina P. Castaño by approving the City of Miami codesignation of Southwest 25th Avenue from Southwest 21st Terrace to Southwest 22nd Street as “Avenida Josefina P. Castaño”,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Miami codesignation of Southwest 25th Avenue from Southwest 21st Terrace to Southwest 22nd Street as “Avenida Josefina P. Castaño”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Miami, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, the City of Miami Police Department, and the City of Miami Fire Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:



A RESOLUTION OF THE MIAMI CITY COMMISSION CODESIGNATING SOUTHWEST 25TH AVENUE FROM SOUTHWEST 21ST TERRACE TO SOUTHWEST 22ND STREET, MIAMI, FLORIDA, AS "AVENIDA JOSEFINA P. CASTANO;" FURTHER DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO COMPLY WITH THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA, AS AMENDED, AS STATED HEREIN AND TO INSTRUCT THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE HEREIN DESIGNATED OFFICES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to a City Commission directive, the Miami Street Codesignation Review Committee, at its meeting of August 10, 2005, reviewed and recommended the proposal for street codesignation of Southwest 25th Avenue from Southwest 21st Terrace to Southwest 22nd Street, Miami, Florida, as "Avenida Josefina P. Castano;"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The recitals and findings contained in the Preamble to this Resolution are adopted by reference and incorporated as if fully set forth in this Section.

Section 2. Southwest 25th Avenue from Southwest 21st Terrace to Southwest 22nd Street, Miami, Florida, is codesignated as "Avenida Josefina P. Castano."

Section 3. The City Manager is directed to instruct the Director of Public Works to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the Departments of Police, Fire-Rescue, Solid Waste, Miami-Dade County Public Works and the United States Postal Service.

Section 4. The City Manager is directed to implement this Resolution and to comply with Sections 54-137 and 54-138 of the Code of the City of Miami, Florida, as amended, entitled "Street Codesignation," in all respects.

Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and signature of the Mayor.{1}
