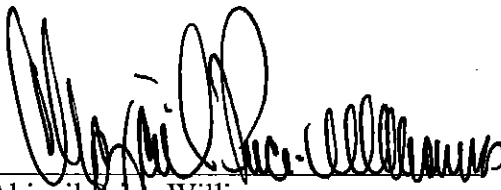

RESOLUTION URGING THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT") TO OPEN THE BRIDGE ON NW 170TH STREET OVER INTERSTATE-75 TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC; DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR THE MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PARTNER WITH FDOT AND OTHER APPROPRIATE OR NECESSARY AGENCIES TO FURTHER THE OBJECTIVE OF OPENING THE BRIDGE ON NW 170TH STREET OVER INTERSTATE-75 TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC AND TO PROVIDE A STATUS REPORT

**WHEREAS**, a bridge, built by the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") in 1984, extends NW 170th Street—a two-lane residential street running along a canal—over Interstate-75 ("I-75"); and

**WHEREAS**, NW 170th Street is closed to vehicular traffic just west of NW 89th Avenue before it passes over I-75; and

**WHEREAS**, development is beginning to spur in the area west of I-75 near NW 170th Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the bridge extending NW 170th Street over I-75 and its approaches are within the jurisdiction of FDOT; and

**WHEREAS**, opening the bridge extending NW 170th Street over I-75 may minimize traffic congestion and increase the flow of traffic, benefiting those who reside and work in the area,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA,** that this Board:

**Section 1.** Urges the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") to open the bridge on NW 170th Street over Interstate-75 to vehicular traffic and to make any necessary improvements to the FDOT right-of-way.

**Section 2.** Directs the Mayor or the Mayor's designee to partner with FDOT and other appropriate or necessary agencies to further the objective of opening the bridge on NW 170th Street over Interstate-75 to vehicular traffic and to provide a status report to this Board, including any recommendations regarding actions that would impose a fiscal impact on the County, within 90 days of the effective date of this resolution and to place the completed report on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.

**Section 3.** Directs the Clerk of this Board to send a certified copy of this resolution to the Governor and the Secretary of the Florida Department of Transportation.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Chairman Esteban L. Bovo, Jr. It was offered by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

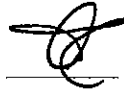
