Subject: Resolution Approving the Plat of DCT Commerce Center

Recommendation

The following plat is hereby submitted for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners (Board) for approval. This plat for DCT Commerce Center is bounded on the north by NW 17 Street, on the east by NW 129 Avenue, on the south by NW 13 Street and on the west by NW 130 Avenue.

The Miami-Dade County Plat Committee recommends approval of this plat. The Plat Committee is comprised of representatives from:

- Florida Department of Transportation;
- Florida Department of Health;
- Miami-Dade County School Board; and
- Miami-Dade County departments of Fire Rescue; Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces; Regulatory and Economic Resources; Transportation and Public Works; and Water and Sewer.

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 16-73, this quasi-judicial matter may be submitted directly for placement on the Board's meeting agenda by the Director of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

Scope

This plat is located in Commission District 12, which is represented by Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

If this plat is approved, the fiscal impact to the County would be approximately \$4,300.00 per year for the maintenance of new roadway construction adjacent to and within the project. These costs would be covered by the Department of Transportation and Public Works' annual General Fund allocation.

Track Record/Monitor

The Development Services Division of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources administers the processing of plats and waivers of plat, and the person responsible for this function is Raul A. Pino, P.L.S.

- Located in Section 35, Township 53 South, Range 39 East.
- Zoning: IU-1.
- Proposed usage: industrial sites.

- Number of parcels: seven (7).
- This plat meets concurrency.
- Full scale copy of the plat and legal description of the boundaries of the land being subdivided, as well as the plat restrictions contained therein, are on file with the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

Mobilization, clearing embankment, maintenance of traffic, paving, drainage, milling, resurfacing, sidewalks, curb and gutter, valley gutter, curb, street name signs, traffic control signs, striping, detectable warning and surfacing, and monumentation are bonded under bond number 8003 in the amount of \$1,672,148.00.

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLAT OF DCT COMMERCE CENTER, LOCATED IN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 53 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST (BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY NW 17 STREET, ON THE EAST BY NW 129 AVENUE, ON THE SOUTH BY NW 13 STREET AND ON THE WEST BY NW 130 AVENUE)

WHEREAS, DCT PAN American Southeast, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, has this day presented to this Board a plat of certain lands lying in Miami-Dade County, Florida, said plat to be known as DCT Commerce Center, the same being a replat of Blocks 3, 6, 11, and 14, of "Western Miami Section A", according to the plat thereof, as recorded in Plat Book 27, Page 34, and Blocks 19, 22, and a portion of Block 27, of "Western Miami Section C", according to the plat thereof, as recorded in Plat Book 27, Page 54, both of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and those portions of Second Street (known as NW 13 Street), Third Street (known as NW 13 Terrace), Fifth Street (known as NW 14 Terrace) and Seventh Street (known as NW 16 Street), lying between Chelsea Avenue (known as NW 130 Avenue) and Walbrok Avenue (known as NW 129 Avenue), lying within the boundaries of both plats vacated by Resolution No. R-83-15, Miami-Dade County, Florida, lying in the Southeast 1/4 of Section 35, Township 53 South, Range 39 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida, and it appears that all requirements of law concerning said plat insofar as the authority of this Board is concerned have been complied with,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that said plat is hereby approved; that the dedication of the streets, alleys and other rights-of-way however designated or depicted on said plat is hereby accepted; that the Miami-Dade County Plat Restrictions as listed

on said plat are approved and are to be enforced; that approval of the plat is not a waiver of any zoning regulations and that the requirements of the zoning existing on this land at the time this resolution is approved shall be enforced whether or not the various parcels on this plat conform to those requirements.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

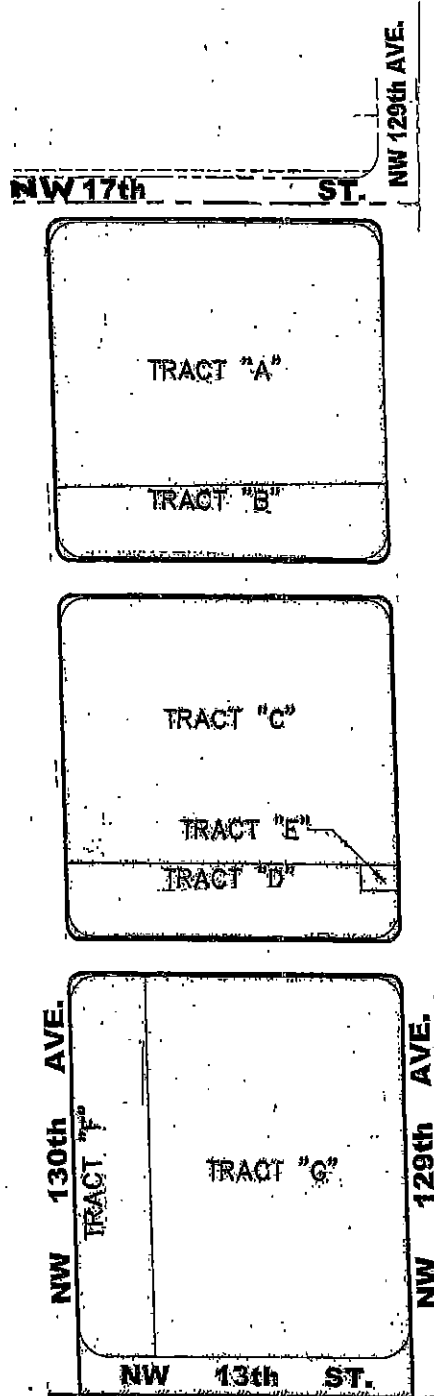
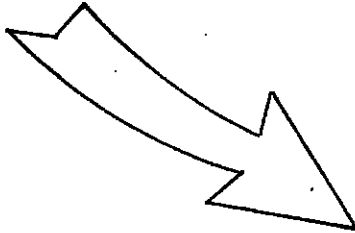
