RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXPAND AND IMPLEMENT FREE WI-FI ACCESS IN ALL MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PARKS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THROUGH THE USE OF EXISTING PARK INFRASTRUCTURE AND MARKETING PARTNERSHIPS, AND TO REPORT BACK TO THE BOARD ON THE PROGRESS THEREOF WITHIN 60 DAYS

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County has one of the largest park systems in the United States with approximately 260 parks that serve over 2.5 million residents; and

WHEREAS, currently, however, only a handful of Miami-Dade County park and recreation facilities offer free wi-fi access to visitors; and

WHEREAS, providing free wi-fi to visitors to County parks would be an additional service and amenity that Miami-Dade County could offer its residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, accordingly, this Board desires to direct the County Mayor or Mayor's designee to expand and implement free wi-fi access in all Miami-Dade County parks including, but not limited to, through the use of existing park infrastructure and the County's Marketing Partnership Program set forth in section 2-2201 of the Miami-Dade County Code and Implementing Order 8-9 ("Marketing Partnership Program"); and

WHEREAS, the expansion and implementation of the free wi-fi should include the placement of firewalls and other appropriate security filters so as to protect children and families from accessing pornographic, violent or other non-age appropriate sites using the County's wi-fi network; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to have the County Mayor or Mayor's designee report back to this Board on the progress of the implementation and expansion of free wi-fi within all Miami-Dade County parks within 60 days of this resolution or, to the extent that the County Mayor or Mayor's designee is unable to undertake such implementation and expansion of free wi-fi due to budgetary constraints or for any other reason, the County Mayor or Mayor's designee shall report in writing to this Board within 60 days of this resolution on the reasons therefore,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated as is fully set forth herein and are approved.

Section 2. This Board directs the County Mayor or Mayor's designee to expand and implement free wi-fi access in all Miami-Dade County parks including, but not limited to, doing so through the use of existing park infrastructure and the Marketing Partnership Program. The expansion and implementation of the free wi-fi should include the placement of firewalls and other appropriate security filters so as to protect children and families from accessing pornographic, violent or other non-age appropriate sites using the County's wi-fi network.

Section 3. This Board further directs the County Mayor or Mayor's designee to report back to this Board on the progress of the implementation and expansion of free wi-fi within all Miami-Dade County parks within 60 days of this resolution or, to the extent that the County Mayor or Mayor's designee is unable to undertake such implementation and expansion of free wi-fi due to budgetary constraints or for any other reason, the County Mayor or Mayor's designee shall report in writing to this Board within 60 days of this resolution on the reasons therefore. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65, the completed report shall be placed on an agenda of the Board.
