Committee and extending the sunset date

On September 4, 2013, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) adopted Ordinance No. 13-78, creating the South B Municipal Advisory Committee (MAC). On September 1, 2015, the Board adopted Ordinance No. 15-85, extending the MAC for an additional two years. The proposed ordinance amends Ordinance 15-85 extending the sunset date of the MAC for up to one year, allowing the MAC to complete the incorporation study and conduct the two required public hearings prior to recommending the incorporation proposal move forward to the Board for consideration. There is no fiscal impact associated with extending the MAC an additional year.

ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SOUTH B MUNICIPAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE CREATED TO STUDY THE POSSIBLE INCORPORATION OF A MUNICIPALITY IN THE SOUTH B AREA IN COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICT 9; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 15-85 TO EXTEND THE SUNSET DATE OF THE COMMITTEE FOR UP TO ONE YEAR; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, EXCLUSION FROM THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on September 4, 2013, the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") adopted Ordinance No. 13-78 which created the South B Municipal Advisory Committee in County Commission District 9 and directed the committee to study the possible incorporation of a municipality in the South B area; and

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2014, the South B Municipal Advisory Committee was organized and began to meet; and

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2015, the Board adopted Ordinance No. 15-85 related to the South B Municipal Advisory Committee, Section 2 of which included the following sunset provision: "[n]otwithstanding any ordinance or provisions of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida to the contrary, the South B Municipal Advisory Committee shall remain in existence until the latter of (i) the date that the Board of County Commissioners votes to defer, approve or deny a resolution submitting the incorporation question to the resident electors of the South B area, or (ii) 12 months from the effective date of this ordinance. It is provided, however, that in no event shall the South B Municipal Advisory Committee exist for more than two years from the effective date of this ordinance;" and

WHEREAS, by operation of the above sunset provision the South B Municipal Advisory Committee is set to sunset on September 11, 2017 and additional time is needed for the committee to conduct its public hearings and attend to other required duties,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this ordinance.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 15-85 is amended to replace Section 2 with the following language: "Notwithstanding any ordinance or provisions of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida to the contrary, the South B Municipal Advisory Committee shall remain in existence until the earlier of (i) the date that the Board of County Commissioners votes to defer, approve or deny a resolution submitting the incorporation question to the resident electors of the South B area or (ii) September 11, 2018.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 4. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance, including any sunset provision, shall be excluded from the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective 10 days after the date of enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an override by this Board.
