WHEREAS, benches at designated transit bus stops are intended for the comfort and convenience of transit patrons while awaiting a bus; and

SHELTERS THE REQUIREMENT THAT BENCHES WITHIN SAID SHELTERS SHALL CONTAIN AT LEAST ONE

ARMREST IN THE MIDDLE PORTION OF THE BENCH

WHEREAS, providing armrests would increase the comfort of those patrons seated at each bus passenger bench; and

WHEREAS, lying across bus passenger benches is inconsistent with the intended use of such benches and reduces the available space for individuals wishing to sit,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are adopted herein by reference.

Section 2. This Board directs the County Mayor or Mayor's designee to include in future competitive solicitations for bus passenger shelters the requirement that benches within said shelters shall contain at least one armrest in the middle portion of the bench.
