Ordinance Amending the Chadustry Estates Multipurpose Maintenance and Street

Lighting Special Taxing District

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve a petition submitted in accordance with Article 1, Chapter 18, of the Code of Miami-Dade County (Code) to amend Ordinance No. 05-02 (Ordinance), which created the Chadustry Estates Multipurpose Maintenance and Street Lighting Special Taxing District (Special Taxing District).

Scope

This Special Taxing District lies within District 9, which is represented by Commissioner Dennis C. Moss, and the multipurpose maintenance services will be dissolved at the earliest practicable time if this ordinance is approved by the Board.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The proposed ordinance amendment will result in no fiscal impact to Miami-Dade County (County). There will be no increase or decrease in County staffing due to the dissolution of the multipurpose maintenance services. If this ordinance amendment is approved, the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department (PROS) will determine if the District has any excess funds that will not be needed for multipurpose maintenance services, which would then be refunded to the property owners. Property owners would continue to be assessed for street lighting services.

Social Equity Statement

The proposed ordinance amends the Special Taxing District, pursuant to Article I, Section 1.01(A)(11), of the Miami-Dade County Home Rule Charter and Chapter 18 of the Code. If approved, property owners within the Special Taxing District will pay a reduced special assessment appropriately apportioned according to the special benefit they receive from the Special Taxing District's lighting services regardless of their demographics, and the total estimated amount of the special assessment to be levied would not be in excess of such special benefit. The dissolution of this Special Taxing District's multipurpose maintenance services, which was requested by 100 percent of the property owners, will cease at the earliest practicable time.

Track Record/Monitor

The Special Taxing District is managed by PROS and overseen by the Chief of the Special Taxing Districts Division (Division), Michael R. Bauman,

**Background** 

The Special Taxing District was created on January 20, 2005, by Ordinance No. 05-02 and provides multipurpose maintenance and street lighting services. Contingent upon Board approval of the amending ordinance, the Special Taxing District's multipurpose maintenance services will be dissolved. Services should be continued by the residents. The street lighting services will remain active. The facilities provided will remain the property of Florida Power and Light (FPL). FPL will continue to be responsible for the maintenance, repairs, upgrades, and replacement of the light fixtures, lamps, poles, and all connecting service lines. The Division will continue to administer FPL's agreement, installation, and billing process.



AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 05-2ORDINANCE CHADUSTRY **ESTATES** RELATING TO THE MAINTENANCE STREET MULTIPURPOSE LIGHTING SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, GENERALLY BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY SW 161 STREET, ON THE EAST BY SW 152 AVENUE, ON THE SOUTH BY SW 162 STREET, AND ON THE WEST BY THEORETICAL SW 153 AVENUE; **TAXING** DISTRICT: RENAMING THE SPECIAL DISCONTINUING THE MULTIPURPOSE MAINTENANCE SERVICES: DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR DESIGNEE TO PREPARE A REVISED PRELIMINARY ASSESSMENT ROLL: PROVIDING FOR EXCLUSION FROM THE CODE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on January 20, 2005, this Board passed Ordinance No. 05-2, creating the Chadustry Estates Multipurpose Maintenance and Street Lighting Special Taxing District ("Special Taxing District"); and

WHEREAS, on January 20, 2005, the Board adopted the Special Taxing District's Preliminary Assessment Rolls per Resolution No. R-6-05; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1.01(A)(11) of the Miami-Dade County Charter; the Board has the authority to abolish and discontinue services within special taxing districts established pursuant to Chapter 18 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida ("Code"); and

WHEREAS, a petition to amend Ordinance No. 05-2 to discontinue the multipurpose maintenance services of the Special Taxing District, duly signed by 100 percent of the resident owners of property within the Special Taxing District, was submitted to the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department ("PROS"), which reviewed and checked the petition against the Property Appraiser's records; and

WHEREAS, upon confirmation of the resident-owner requirement, PROS transmitted a copy of the petition to the Clerk, and the Clerk transmitted a copy thereof to the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee who examined it and filed with the Clerk a memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated in this Ordinance by reference, setting forth the background of the Special Taxing District and recommending that the Special Taxing District be amended; and

WHEREAS, the memorandum of the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee recommends amending the services provided to the Special Taxing District to discontinue multipurpose maintenance services to all properties within the Special Taxing District; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk will certify the place, date, and hour for a public hearing on the petition of the property owners and the memorandum at which all interested persons will be afforded the opportunity to present for this Board's consideration their objections, if any, to the amendment of the improvement(s) and/or services to be provided to the Special Taxing District; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was held during the meeting of this Board on Tuesday,

, beginning at 9:30 a.m. in the Commission Chambers, Stephen P. Clark Center, 111 NW 1st Street, Miami, Florida,

# BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. This Board adopts and incorporates the matters set forth in the foregoing recitals as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. The Chadustry Estates Multipurpose Maintenance and Street Lighting Special Taxing District shall be renamed the Chadustry Estates Street Lighting Special Taxing District.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 05-2 is hereby amended to discontinue the multipurpose maintenance services.

Section 4. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee is directed to cause to be prepared and filed with the Clerk a revised Preliminary Assessment Roll for the street lighting improvements and/or services, in accordance with the provisions of sections 18-14 and 18-22.1 of the Code. As authorized by section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, all special assessments levied and imposed under the provisions of this Ordinance shall be collected, subject to the provisions of Chapter 197, Florida Statutes, in the same manner and at the same time as ad valorem taxes. Unless paid when due, such assessments shall be deemed delinquent and payment thereof may be enforced by means of the procedures provided by the provisions of Chapter 197, Florida Statutes, and/or section 18-14(8) of the Code, including possible loss of title.

Section 5. Except to discontinue the multipurpose maintenance services in the Special Taxing District as provided herein, this Ordinance does not affect, amend or modify Ordinance No. 05-2.

Section 6 A duly certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and recorded in the appropriate book of records.

Section 7. It is the intention of the Board, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance be excluded from the Code.

Section 8. The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective ten days after the date of enactment, unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an override by this Board.
