Subject: Recommendation to Reject All Bids, Access Control Point Barrier Systems

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the rejection of all bids received under *Invitation to Bid No. FB-00555, Access Control Point Barrier Systems*, for the Miami-Dade Aviation Department. The solicitation was issued to establish a full service contract for the Access Control Point Barrier Systems and Traffic Gate Arms Systems located at Miami International Airport. The requested services include on-site staffing, routine and emergency repairs, preventive maintenance and inspections.

The County issued a solicitation under full and open competition. Six bids were received in response to the solicitation, including two "No Bids." During the evaluation of bids, staff discovered the required licenses as outlined in the solicitation were inaccurate. The solicitation incorrectly required vendors to possess an active mechanical or general contractor license. Upon further review, staff discovered that an electrical contractor license and a mechanical contractor license are both required to perform the solicited services. The County has prepared a replacement solicitation identifying the correct licenses and anticipates advertisement in October 2017.

Scope

The scope of this item would have been countywide in nature

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

There is no fiscal impact to the County for the rejection of bids.
