RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PROVIDE A REPORT TO THE BOARD WITHIN 60 DAYS ON OUTSTANDING DELINQUENT EMPOWERMENT ZONE COMMERCIAL LOANS AND IMPLEMENTED OR PROPOSED STRATEGIES FOR COLLECTION OR WRITE-OFF

WHEREAS, in 1999 the Board approved a Memorandum of Understanding (the "MOU") between Miami-Dade County (the "County") and the Miami-Dade Empowerment Trust ("MDET"), that delegated authority to MDET to govern, direct, and implement the Empowerment Zone Strategic Plan; and

WHEREAS, on July 10, 2007, the County terminated the MOU with MDET; and

WHEREAS, this Board passed and adopted Resolution No. R-304-08 whereby the County approved a Program Assumption Agreement and Transition Plan with MDET, which among other things transferred certain assets of MDET to the County, including the empowerment zone commercial loan portfolio; and

WHEREAS, Implementing Order No. 3-9 delineates departmental responsibilities over the administration of customer accounts receivable and actions required to adjust uncollectible accounts receivable; and

WHEREAS, numerous empowerment zone commercial loans have been deemed uncollectable and written off; and

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**WHEREAS**, the current balance of delinquent empowerment zone commercial loans in the portfolio is \$401,613.60,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee is directed to provide a report to the Board within 60 days, in accordance with Ordinance No. 14-65, on outstanding delinquent empowerment zone commercial loans, and implemented or proposed strategies for collection or write off.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Jean Monestime. It was offered by Commissioner , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
