

RESOLUTION NO. _____

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF SW
20TH STREET FROM SW 97TH AVENUE TO SW 107TH
AVENUE AS "PEDRO ENCINOSA WAY"

WHEREAS, on April 17, 1961, a group of 1,334 men, known as Brigade 2506, traveled on a seaborne force to Cuba to overthrow Fidel Castro, with 1,297 men actually landing on Cuban shores and joined by an additional 177 airborne paratroops; and

WHEREAS, the invasion was unsuccessful, resulting in an estimated 114 men who drowned or were killed in action and another 1,183 men who were captured and imprisoned; and

WHEREAS, Pedro Encinosa was a member of Brigade 2506, eventually serving as the President of the Bay of Pigs Veterans' Association; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Encinosa passed away on November 9, 2010; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor Mr. Encinosa's legacy by codesignating that portion of SW 20th Street from SW 97th Avenue to SW 107th Avenue as "Pedro Encinosa Way"; and

WHEREAS, that portion of SW 20th Street from SW 97th Avenue to SW 107th Avenue is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates that portion of SW 20th Street from SW 97th Avenue to SW 107th Avenue as "Pedro Encinosa Way".

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade County Police Department, and the Miami-Dade County Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
