Request for Additional Expenditure Authority to Sole Source Contract No. SS9862-

0/18, EZ-IO Intraosseous Infusion Systems and Related Items

This item was amended at the October 11, 2017 Public Safety and Health Committee meeting to remove the reference to the minimum requirements for the EZ-IO device outlined in the Florida Administrative Code.

### Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners authorize additional expenditure authority to *Contract No. SS9862-0/18*, EZ-IO Intraosseous Infusion Systems (EZ-IO) and Related Items, for the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department. The department is requesting \$185,000 in additional expenditure authority in order to continue purchasing EZ-IO systems for emergency response units.

The County awarded this sole source contract on May 27, 2016 for a two-year term. Fire Rescue utilizes this contract to purchase EZ-IO intraosseous vascular access systems, which provide emergency responders and medical professionals with direct access to veins located in bone marrow for the purpose of injecting medication. The EZ-IO device provided by the vendor under this contract is the only battery-operated product available in the marketplace.

Fire Rescue is requesting additional expenditure authority due to a 20 percent increase in the use of EZ-IOs, which is anticipated to continue through the end of the contract term. The increase in usage resulted from the expansion of advanced life support response units that are equipped with this device. Additionally, modifications have been made to Fire Rescue's internal protocols to align with the latest recommendations from the American Heart Association relating to the management of cardiac arrests, which has resulted in an increased need for these devices.

#### Scope

The impact of this item is countywide in nature.

# Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The contract term expires on May 26, 2018. The contract has a current cumulative allocation of \$250,000. If this request is approved, the contract will have a modified cumulative value of \$435,000.
