RESOLUTION URGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE AND COMMISSIONER OF AGRICULTURE AND CONSUMER SERVICES TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE MARKETING AND PROMOTION OF THE 2019 MIAMI INTERNATIONAL AGRICULTURE, HORSE AND CATTLE SHOW

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County (the "County") has a long history in both agriculture and cattle in a state known for both; and

WHEREAS, the County's agricultural industry employs more than 20,000 people and produces more than \$2.7 billion in economic impact each year; and

WHEREAS, agricultural activities constitute a significant source of revenue for the County, and revenue generated in the County accounts for over 32 percent of the state's total; and

WHEREAS, the first Miami International Agriculture, Horse and Cattle Show was held in 2008 and began with the goals of promoting Florida's agriculture industry, providing beef producers with international commerce opportunities and improving agricultural education in the County; and

WHEREAS, the Miami International Agriculture, Horse and Cattle Show is generally held in April each year at the Ronald Reagan Equestrian Center at Tropical Park, a premier park in the County Parks system; and

WHEREAS, the Miami International Agriculture, Horse & Cattle Show has evolved into a prime opportunity to highlight the significance of agriculture and cattle in the County and to showcase the latest products, services and technologies in the agriculture industry; and

WHEREAS, the event also attracts agri-business enterprises from Latin America, the Caribbean, and Europe, along with businessmen and visitors from throughout the United States, and as such has served to develop the County's potential as a gateway between international and domestic markets in the agriculture industry; and

WHEREAS, the Miami International Agriculture, Horse & Cattle Show draws over 60,000 visitors annually, with representatives from over 24 countries including Argentina, Brazil, Guatemala, and Panama, and cattle breeders from over 18 states including Florida, Georgia, Texas, Arizona, Arkansas and Missouri, who have exhibited over a dozen breeds of cattle at the show; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to urge the Florida Legislature and Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Services to provide funding for the marketing and promotion of the 2019 Miami International Agriculture, Horse & Cattle Show,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges the Florida Legislature and Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Services to provide funding for the marketing and promotion of the 2019 Miami International Agriculture, Horse & Cattle Show.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Governor, and Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Senate President, House Speaker, and the Chair and Members of the Miami-Dade State Legislative Delegation.

Section 3. Directs the County's state lobbyists to advocate for the appropriation set forth in Section 1 above, and authorizes and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to amend the 2018 State Legislative Package to include this item.
