RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PROMINENTLY AND **COMMEMORATIVE** PERMANENTLY A DISPLAY PORTRAIT IN HONOR OF THE LONGEST SERVING COUNTY ATTORNEY, ROBERT A. GINSBURG, IN THE STEPHEN P. CLARK CENTER, AND PRESENT THE PORTRAIT ATANUNVEILING COMMEMORATIVE **CEREMONY** 

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners notes with profound sorrow the passing of Robert A. Ginsburg, the longest serving County Attorney in the history of Miami-Dade County, who was the leader of the County Attorney's Office for 25 years from 1980 to 2005; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ginsburg, widely acclaimed as a preeminent local government lawyer and staunch protector of Miami-Dade County's Home Rule Charter, led the County through many challenging times, including the 2000 Bush-Gore recount, the 1980 McDuffie riots, the Decade of Progress bond issuances, the aftermath of Hurricane Andrew and the Mariel boatlift; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ginsburg, who served as counsel to Miami-Dade County and to numerous County Commissioners and Mayors and whose legacy lives on as the heart and soul of the County Attorney's Office, always pursued the right result with distinction, loyalty and excellence, and will long be remembered for his professionalism, honesty, integrity, fairness, promotion of diversity and drive to govern fairly; and

WHEREAS, it is highly appropriate that Robert A. Ginsburg should be honored and remembered with a portrait installed in the lobby of the Stephen P. Clark Center; and

WHEREAS, members of the legal community who have had the honor to work with Robert A. Ginsburg will fund the cost for commissioning portrait artist Jeffrey W. Bass to paint a portrait of Robert A. Ginsburg that will take from 6 to 8 months (see sample work attached as Exhibit A and Exhibit B); and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to recognize Mr. Ginsburg by directing the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to prominently and permanently display, at an unveiling ceremony, a portrait which will be painted in his honor,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to prominently and permanently display a commemorative portrait in honor of Robert A. Ginsburg, along with an accompanying engraved plague identifying the portrait, in the lobby of the Stephen P. Clark Center, which portrait will be presented at an unveiling ceremony upon the artist's completion of the portrait.
