Recommendation for Approval to Establish a Prequalification Pool for Installation,

Maintenance, and Modernization of Elevators, Escalators, and Moving Walkways

# **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the establishment of a prequalification pool, RTQ-00687, Installation, Maintenance, and Modernization of Elevators, Escalators, and Moving Walkways for multiple County Departments. This pool provides for the purchase, installation, maintenance, repair, upgrade, replacement, and modernization of elevators, escalators, moving walkways, and all related equipment. The County is currently using Emergency Contract No. E9946-0/18 for these services. Ratification of the emergency contract will be presented to the Board as a separate item.

Proactively establishing this pool will address ongoing maintenance and repair needs for elevators countywide. There are currently six other elevator contracts in effect. There have been a number of performance issues by vendors across all contracts that has impacted critical, life safety elevator operations countywide. Establishing this new pool allows County departments additional contracting opportunities to address these needs.

This pool will allow the County to increase competition and the availability of vendors to provide these services. The pool is being established with all responsive, responsible vendors who met the minimum qualifications set forth in solicitation. Additional vendors may be added at any time during the term of the pool, subject to Board ratification.

#### Scope

The scope of this item is countywide in nature.

## Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact for the five-year term is \$44,448,000.

#### **Delegated Authority**

Upon approval of this item, a pool of pre-qualified vendors will be established to participate in spot market competitions. The County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee will have the authority to (a) solicit pricing and award contracts up to an aggregate amount of the allocation authorized by the Board. The County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee will also have the authority to (b) exercise all provisions of the solicitation documents and any resulting contracts pursuant to Section 2-8.1 of the County Code and Implementing Order 3-38 and (c) add vendors to the pool at any time, subject to ratification by the Board on a bi-annual basis.

# **Due Diligence**

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ESTABLISHMENT OF PREQUALIFICATION POOL RTQ-00687 IN A TOTAL AMOUNT UP TO \$44,448,000.00 FOR THE PURCHASE MAINTENANCE, INSTALLATION, OF MODERNIZATION OF ELEVATORS, ESCALATORS, AND MOVING WALKWAYS FOR VARIOUS COUNTY DEPARTMENTS FOR AN INITIAL TERM OF FIVE YEARS; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO SOLICIT PRICING, AWARD CONTRACTS, EXERCISE ALL PROVISIONS OF THE SOLICITATION DOCUMENTS AND ANY RESULTING CONTRACTS PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-8.1 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA AND IMPLEMENTING ORDER 3-38, AND ADD VENDORS TO THE POOL AT ANY TIME, SUBJECT TO RATIFICATION BY THE BOARD ON A BI-ANNUAL BASIS

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board authorizes the establishment of prequalification pool RTQ-00687 for the purchase of installation, maintenance, and modernization of elevators, escalators, and moving walkways for various County departments in a total amount up to \$44,448,000.00 for an initial term of five years; and authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to (a) solicit pricing and award contracts up to an aggregate amount of the allocation authorized by the Board, (b) exercise all provisions of the solicitation documents and any resulting contracts pursuant to Section 2-8.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida

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and Implementing Order 3-38, and (c) add vendors to the pool at any time, subject to ratification by the Board on a bi-annual basis. A copy of the solicitation document and resulting contracts are on file and available upon request from the Internal Services Department, Procurement Management Services Division.
