	RESOLUTION DECLARING THE M WATER CONSERVATION MO	IONTH OF APRIL 2018 AS NTH IN MIAMI-DADI	

COUNTY

WHEREAS, clean, safe, and sustainable water resources and supplies are vital to Florida's economy, environment, residents, visitors, and quality of life; and

WHEREAS, economic development depends on a clean and healthy environment, as every category of water user including commercial, industrial, agricultural, institutional, hospitality, and residential can make positive contributions to conserve Florida's water resources; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County is committed to the development and implementation of sound water use, efficiency practices, guidelines, and policies, as the State of Florida, along with local partners, are investing billions of dollars to restore the Everglades, develop alternative water supplies, reduce stormwater pollution, upgrade drinking water facilities, and improve wastewater treatment; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida, the South Florida Water Management District and Miami-Dade County have worked together to develop and implement a Comprehensive Water Conservation Program that instills a lasting culture of conservation in our communities; and

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County, through the implementation of goal-based water conservation practices, has saved an estimated 15.34 million gallons of water per day since executing the 20-Year Water Use Efficiency Plan in 2007,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the Board of County Commissioners hereby designates the month of April 2018 as Water Conservation Month in Miami-Dade County and urges all water users to take action by increasing their water use efficiency and take appropriate measures to conserve and protect our State's most vital natural resource.
