<u>Recommendation</u>

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners grant the attached Road Closing Petition following a public hearing, and contingent on the recording of the plat of "CARRIE MEEK WAREHOUSE DISTRIBUTION CENTER", tentative plat T-23859. In the event the plat is not approved, this resolution becomes null and void. The Miami-Dade County (County) Departments of Regulatory and Economic Resources, Transportation and Public Works (DTPW), Water and Sewer, and Fire Rescue have no objection to this right-of-way being closed.

Scope

This road closing is located within District 1, which is represented by Commissioner Barbara J. Jordan.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The property abutting the right-of-way to be abandoned is tax exempt. Therefore, the granting of this petition will not result in an increase in revenue from property taxes. The fee for this road closing is \$1,960.00, which is paid by the Petitioner.

Track Record/Monitor

DTPW is the entity overseeing this project and the person responsible for monitoring is Leandro Oña, P.E., Chief, Roadway Engineering and Right-of-Way Division.

Background

The property owner, The Miami-Dade County Aviation Department, wishes to close Fatima Street from Fisherman Road South for approximately 422 feet in order to incorporate the land into the proposed plat of "CARRIE MEEK WAREHOUSE DISTRIBUTION CENTER", tentative plat T-23859. The release of this right-of-way to County will allow the completion of the proposed development of this site.

The subject right-of-way was dedicated in 1929 by "PLAT NO. ONE-GOLF COURSE SECTION OF OPA LOCKA" recorded in Plat Book 33, Page 74 of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The subject right-of-way and surrounding area are designated as "Terminals".

RESOLUTION GRANTING PETITION TO CLOSE FATIMA STREET FROM FISHERMAN ROAD SOUTH FOR APPROXIMATELY 422 FEET (ROAD CLOSING PETITION NO. P-933)

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, (1) that, subject to the recordation of the plat of CARRIE MEEK WAREHOUSE DISTRIBUTION CENTER, tentative plat T-23859, the alley, avenue, street, highway or other place used for travel as described in the attached petition is hereby vacated, abandoned and closed, all rights of Miami-Dade County and the public in and to the same are hereby renounced and disclaimed; (2) it is found that the action will serve a public purpose and benefit the public without violating private property rights; (3) that the procedure utilized in the adoption of this resolution is expressly ratified and approved; and (4) the Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of the adoption of this resolution one time within thirty (30) days hereafter in a newspaper of general circulation of Miami-Dade County.



6. GROUNDS FOR REQUESTING PETITION AND PROPOSED USE FOR THE LAND BY THIS REQUEST: The undersigned submits as a grounds and reasons in support of this petition the following (state in detail, why petition should be granted):

The roadway segment is a remnant of a 1929 plat, showing lot sites at a time when the surrounding property was used as a golf course. The subdivision was never improved, and the area was converted to aviation uses during WWII. The entire plat area (and the surrounding lands) are now part of the Miami-Opa locka Executive Airport. The roadway was never improved, and the right-of-way does not connect to any other roadways or rights-of-way. The vacation will permit the property to be used for further development in accordance with the proposed plat currently being reviewed by the County. The vacation of the roadway is further consistent with the prior action of the Board of County Commissioners approving the Second Amendment to the Carrie Meek Foundation lease, which contemplated the development of the entirety of the parent tract within which the old plat is located.






