Resolution Approving the Plat of Dolphin Park and Ride

### <u>Recommendation</u>

The following plat is submitted for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners (Board) for approval. This plat for Dolphin Park and Ride is bounded on the north approximately 300 feet south of theoretical NW 14 Street, on the east by the Florida Turnpike, on the south by NW 12 Street, and on the west by theoretical NW 121 Avenue.

The Miami-Dade County Plat Committee recommends approval of this plat. The Plat Committee is comprised of representatives from:

- Florida Department of Transportation;
- Florida Department of Health;
- · Miami-Dade County School Board; and
- Miami-Dade County Departments of Fire Rescue; Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces; Regulatory and Economic Resources; Transportation and Public Works; and Water and Sewer.

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 16-73, this quasi-judicial matter may be submitted directly for placement on the Board's meeting agenda by the Director of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

A location sketch is attached to this memorandum as Exhibit A.

#### Scope

This plat is located in Commission District 12, which is represented by Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz.

#### Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

If this plat is approved, the fiscal impact to the County would be approximately \$1,400 annually for new roadway and landscaped median construction adjacent to the project. These costs would be covered by the Department of Transportation and Public Works' annual General Fund allocation.

However, the fiscal impact is compensated for through a PTP Bond from the Department of Transportation and Public Works Project No. CIP128.

#### Track Record/Monitor

The Development Services Division of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources administers the processing of plats and waivers of plat, and the person responsible for this function is Raul A. Pino, P.L.S.



RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLAT OF DOLPHIN PARK AND RIDE, LOCATED IN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 36, TOWNSHIP 53 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST (BOUNDED ON THE NORTH APPROXIMATELY 300 FEET SOUTH OF THEORETICAL NW 14 STREET, ON THE EAST BY THE FLORIDA TURNPIKE, ON THE SOUTH BY NW 12 STREET, AND ON THE WEST BY THEORETICAL NW 121 AVENUE) AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE PLAT ON BEHALF OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is in incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, has this day presented to this Board a plat of certain lands lying in Miami-Dade County, Florida, said plat to be known as Dolphin Park and Ride, the same being a subdivision of a portion of land lying and being in the Southeast 1/4 of Section 36, Township 53 South, Range 39 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida, and it appears that all requirements of law concerning said plat insofar as the authority of this Board is concerned have been complied with,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that said plat is hereby approved; that the dedication of the streets, alleys and other rights-of-way however designated or depicted on said plat is hereby accepted; that the Miami-Dade County Plat Restrictions as listed on said plat are approved and are to be enforced; that approval of the plat is not a waiver of any zoning regulations; and that the requirements of the zoning existing on this land at the time this Resolution is approved shall be enforced whether or not the various parcels on this plat conform

to those requirements; that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the plat of Dolphin Park and Ride on behalf of Miami-Dade County in its capacity as fee simple title holder.
