WHEREAS, on March 31, 2018, Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro resigned from the				
office of Miami-Dade County Commissioner, District 5; and				
WHEREAS, the Office of County Commissioner for District 5 is now vacant; and				
WHEREAS, Section 1.07 of the Home Rule Charter requires that vacancies in the office				
of County Commissioner "shall be filled by majority vote of the remaining members of the				
Board within 30 days, or the Board shall call an election to be held not more than 90 days				
thereafter to fill the vacancy"; and				
WHEREAS, if no candidate for such vacancy election receives a majority of the votes				
cast in the election, then Section 1.07 of the Home Rule Charter provides that a "runoff election				
shall be had within 30 days of the certification of election results requiring a runoff"; and				
WHEREAS, Section 1.07 of the Home Rule Charter further provides that a "person				
elected shall serve for the remainder of the unexpired term of office"; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to fill these vacancies by special election held on [

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. In accordance with the provisions of the Miami-Dade County Home Rule Charter and the Code of Miami-Dade County, a special election is hereby called and shall be held in Miami-Dade County, Florida on [], [], 2018, for the purposes of submitting to the qualified electors of County Commission District 5 the candidates to fill the vacancy in the Office of County Commissioner for District 5. If necessary, a special run-off election will be held on [], [], 2018.

Section 2. Notice of such election shall be published in accordance with Section 100.342, Florida Statutes.

Section 3. Candidate qualifying for Miami-Dade County Commissioner, District 5, shall commence at noon on the first day after the effective date of this Resolution and end at 5:00 p.m. on the tenth day after the effective date of this Resolution. The Clerk of the Board shall provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections on the effective date of the Resolution as set forth herein.

Section 4. The result of such election shall be determined by the qualified electors residing within County Commission District 5 voting on the candidates. The polls at such election shall be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on the day of such election.

Section 5. All qualified electors of Miami-Dade County Commission District 5 shall be entitled to vote in the Commission District 5 vacancy election. The County registration books shall remain open at the Office of the Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections until twenty-nine (29) days prior to the date of such election, at which time the registration books will close in accordance with the provisions of general election laws.

Section 6. The form of the ballot for these elections shall be in accordance with the requirements of general election laws.

Section 7. Early voting for these elections shall be conducted for a period of [] days in accordance with the requirements of general election laws. A total of [] early voting sites will be used during this election.

Section 8. Vote-by-mail paper ballots for these elections may be used by qualified electors of Miami-Dade County for voting on this question. The form of such vote-by-mail ballot shall be in accordance with the requirements prescribed by general election laws.

Section 9. A sample ballot showing the manner in which the question or proposal aforesaid will appear at this election shall be published and provided in accordance with the applicable provisions of general election laws.

Section 10. These special elections shall be held and conducted in accordance with applicable provisions of the general laws relating to elections and the provisions of the Miami-Dade County Home Rule Charter. The County Mayor or his or her designee, the Finance Director, and the Clerk of the County Commission are hereby authorized and directed to take all appropriate actions necessary to carry into effect and accomplish the provisions of this resolution. This election shall be a nonpartisan election. Election officials in connection with this election shall be appointed in accordance with the provisions of general election laws.

<u>Section 11.</u> This election shall be canvassed by the County Canvassing Board, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3.07 of the Home Rule Charter.
