



RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXAMINE THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING MONTHLY PREVENTATIVE HEALTH CLASSES AT MIAMI-DADE REGIONAL LIBRARIES, IN PARTNERSHIP WITH LOCAL HOSPITALS, HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, AND COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES, AND TO SUBMIT A WRITTEN REPORT TO THE BOARD

WHEREAS, the medical establishment has long recognized the importance of disease prevention and preventative health care; and

WHEREAS, many residents of Miami-Dade have difficulty accessing preventative health care; and

WHEREAS, the Miami Dade Public Library System has five regional libraries located throughout Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the regional libraries are accessible to many Miami-Dade residents; and

WHEREAS, the regional libraries have the capacity to host preventative health classes for the benefit of the residents of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County is home to several large medical and educational institutions with expertise in preventative health; and

WHEREAS, these healthcare providers and educators could conduct preventative health classes on a pro-bono basis in partnership with the Miami Dade Public Library System; and

WHEREAS, this Board recognizes the significant public health benefit associated preventative health,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Incorporates and approves the above recitals as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to examine the feasibility of establishing monthly preventative health classes at Miami Dade Regional Libraries, in partnership with local hospitals, health care facilities, and colleges and universities.

Section 3. Directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to provide a written report to the Board regarding the directive set forth in Section 2 of this resolution within 90 days of the date of this resolution, which shall be placed on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
