Subject: Resolution Approving the First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement Between Miami-Dade County and the City of Doral for the Provision of Public Transportation Services

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the execution of the First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement (Agreement) between Miami-Dade County (County) and the City of Doral (City) for the Provision of Public Transportation Services in and around the City.

SCOPE

This Agreement has a direct impact on the City which is located in District 12, represented by Commissioner José "Pepe" Diaz. However, due to the connection of service with other County routes, the impact of this service benefits the public, and is, therefore, countywide.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact to the County for this Agreement. The City will be responsible for all operating and maintenance costs of the service. The Doral Circulator Trolley is a fare-free service.

TRACK RECORD/MONITOR

This agenda item is amending the current Agreement between the County and the City for public transportation service. The project manager for this Agreement is Gerald E. Bryan, DTPW's, Section Chief of Transit Service Planning and Scheduling.

BACKGROUND

The existing Agreement was approved by the Board on December 6, 2016, pursuant to Resolution No. R-1164-16. The Agreement is for a five year term, with two five-year automatic option to renew.

The City held a public outreach workshop on September 5, 2017, and a public hearing on March 14, 2018, seeking public input regarding the service modifications. On March 21, 2018, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 18-51, which authorized the City Manager to take such actions as may be necessary to implement these service modifications. A copy of the City's public meeting notices, and Resolution No. 18-51, are included herein.

The objective of the service modifications is to reduce traffic congestion within the City while enhancing connections with County transit services. Key provisions of this Agreement include:

Trolley Route Alignment Adjustments (see Figure 1-A - Trolley Route Map)


- **Route 1** Adjustment of route to provide service to Dolphin Mall Transit Terminal, Doral Legacy Park, and improved connection to Miami-Dade College West Campus.

- **Route 2** Adjustment of route to improve service along NW 36 Street and the NW 79 Avenue corridors, as well as improve service to the Downtown Doral area.
- **Route 3** Adjustment of route to provide service to the Doral Math and Science Academy, and the communities along NW 104 Avenue, between NW 74 Street and NW 66 Street.
- **Route 4** New FIU Trolley Route - a new trolley route that will service the Modesto A. Maidique and Engineering Campuses along NW 107 Avenue. The new trolley route would operate Monday through Friday, between 6:00 AM and 11:00 PM, via two trolley vehicles with an approximate 30-minute headway (frequency).

Doral Trolley Adjustments and Expanded Service Hours (Figure 1-B).

- **Weekday Route 1** Service Hour Adjustment: Adjustment to the weekday Route 1 schedule to have four trolleys providing all day service between 6:00 AM and 10:00 PM. Currently during the weekday peak hours, Route 1 is serviced by four trolleys from 6:00 AM to 10:15 AM and from 2:15 PM to 7:15 PM.
- **Weekday Route 2** Service Hour Adjustment: Extension of the weekday schedule to improve service to the Palmetto Metrorail Station by providing an additional service loop which will extend the service time from 8:03 PM to 9:38 PM.
- **Saturday Route 2** Service Adjustment: With the increase of residents in the Downtown Doral area, and the lack of east-west transit connectivity in the City, commence Route 2 Saturday trolley service.
- **Weekday Route 4** Commence a new trolley route that will service the Modesto A. Maidique and Engineering Campuses along NW 107 Avenue. The new trolley route would operate Monday through Friday between 6:00 AM and 11:00 PM via two trolley vehicles with an approximate 30-minute headway.

All other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain the same.

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY
AND THE CITY OF DORAL FOR THE
PROVISION OF PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICES**

The City of Doral (City) has requested that Miami-Dade County (County) approve an amendment to the Interlocal Agreement between the County and the City for the provision of public transportation services, which was entered into pursuant to County Resolution No. R-1164-16 and City Resolution No. R-16-167.

The City wishes to modify its existing service which is depicted in Figure 1 (Map) of the Interlocal Agreement. The service modifications consist of route alignment adjustments to Routes 1, 2, and 3; weekday service hour expansion on Routes 1 and 2; commencement of Saturday service on Route 2; and the implementation of the Florida International University (FIU) Doral Trolley Service (Route 4). The service modifications are depicted in Figure I-A and I-B, attached herein. All other terms and conditions of the existing Interlocal Agreement remain the same.

The City held a public outreach workshop on September 5, 2017 and a public hearing on March 14, 2018 seeking public input regarding the above referenced service modifications. On March 21, 2018, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 18-51, which authorized the City Manager to take such actions as may be necessary to implement said service modifications.


