

**Subject:** Recommendation to Reject All Bids Video Inspection Services for Leachate Pipes

## **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the rejection of the sole bid received under *Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. FB-00667, Video Inspection Services for Leachate Pipes*.

On September 17, 2018, the County issued a solicitation under full and open competition to obtain video inspection services for the Solid Waste Management and Water and Sewer departments. One bidder responded to the solicitation. Award would have been made to the responsive, responsible bidder in the aggregate who met the qualifications listed in the solicitation and whose offer represented the lowest price when all items were added in the aggregate. The awarded bidder would have been responsible for providing video inspection services of the landfill leachate collection system and under drain piping at three Miami-Dade County landfills.

These services are necessary to maintain compliance with state regulations. Chemical reactions in the leachate collection system can cause clogging through generation of solid residues. The leachate collection systems are required to be water pressure cleaned and video inspected prior to permit renewal by the State of Florida.

During the evaluation of this solicitation, Solid Waste Management's technical staff discovered that the frequency and quantity of services identified in the solicitation were misleading. The estimated quantities implied that the County needed a significantly higher amount of services than is actually required. The solicitation was restructured and advertised, under solicitation number FB-01144, on January 10, 2019, to which two responses were received. The new solicitation structure provides preventative maintenance on an annual basis at the Resources Recovery Landfill, and every two years at the North and South Dade Landfills. Receiving services at these frequencies assists in preventing scale build-up in the pipes. Servicing the leachate pipes infrequently resulted in the need for water blasting services which are significantly more costly than routine preventative maintenance services. The replacement solicitation is anticipated to be awarded under the Mayor's delegated authority.

## **Scope**

The impact would have been countywide in nature.

## **Fiscal Impact/Funding Source**

There is no fiscal impact to the County with the rejection of bids.



- The Living Wage would not have applied.



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


