RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT WITHIN 90 DAYS A WRITTEN REPORT RELATING TO PREQUALIFICATION POOLS FOR THE PURCHASES OF GOODS AND SERVICES

WHEREAS, this Board routinely approves the establishment of prequalification pools for the recurring purchases of a wide range of goods and services; and

WHEREAS, a prequalification pool typically consists of group of vendors qualified to participate in spot market competitions issued by County user departments for identified goods and services; and

WHEREAS, typically, in establishing a prequalification pool, this Board adopts a resolution that approves a prequalified pool of vendors and delegates to the County Mayor a set amount of money to expend on the goods and services identified in the resolution for a specified term of years; and

WHEREAS, in addition to approving resolutions establishing prequalification pools the Board is also routinely presented with resolutions extending the term of existing pools or increasing the Mayor's expenditure authority to purchase the goods and services the pool vendors compete for; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires that the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee analyze the County's procurement processes for establishing prequalification pools and presenting such pools to the Board for approval; and

WHEREAS, this Board also desires that the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee submit written recommendations to the Board on how best to establish and present for the Board's approval prequalification pools for the purchase of goods and services,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated as true and correct.

Section 2. This Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to prepare a written report analyzing the County's procurement processes for establishing prequalification pools and presenting such pools to the Board for approval. The report shall include recommendations on how best to establish and present prequalification pools to the Board for approval. In formulating recommendations, the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee shall strive to promote the goals of uniformity, efficiency, consistency, budgetary transparency, increased competition and increased participation of local and small businesses in prequalification pools. The report shall also prescribe whether to adopt legislation to implement the recommendations relating to prequalification pools.

Section 3. This Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to provide this report to this Board within 90 Days of the effective date of this resolution, and to place the completed report on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Barbara J. Jordan. It was offered by Commissioner , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
