RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR THE MAYOR’S DESIGNEE TO USE ALL MANURE GENERATED AT THE RONALD REAGAN EQUESTRIAN CENTER, ONCE COMPOSTED AND DRIED, FOR THE FERTILIZATION OF ALL COUNTY-OWNED AND MAINTAINED TREES WITHIN COUNTY ROADS IN DISTRICT 10

WHEREAS, there is significant horse manure generated at the Ronald Reagan Equestrian Center located at Tropical Park; and

WHEREAS, horse manure can be easily composted to become a natural organic fertilizer; and

WHEREAS, the use of composted horse manure is a cost-effective way to provide fertilizer to trees; and

WHEREAS, using the composted horse manure within District 10 would ensure that additional resources are not used to transport the composted horse manure to other destinations within the County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Incorporates and approves the above recitals as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Directs the County Mayor or the Mayor’s designee to use all manure generated at the Ronald Reagan Equestrian Center, once composted and dried, for the fertilization of all County-owned and maintained trees within County roads in District 10.
