Subject: Sunscreen Dispenser Pilot Project at Westwind Lakes Park - Directive 181678

At the September 5, 2018 Board of County Commissioners (Board) meeting, the Board approved Resolution No. R-920-18 (Attachment A) directing the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to establish a pilot project whereby the Richard David Kann Melanoma Foundation (the Foundation) shall install a free sunscreen dispenser or dispensers at Westwind Lakes Park, to execute any necessary agreements for this pilot project and to provide a written report to the Board within six months of the effective date of the resolution.

The Foundation is a non-profit organization and was started in 1995 after Richard Kann's passing at age 44 of a late-detected melanoma. The mission of the Foundation is to save lives through education about the prevention and early detection of skin cancer, especially melanoma. The Foundation's vision is to educate children throughout the country and give them the skills necessary to make healthy sun safety choices throughout their lives.

Since its inception, the Foundation's staff and volunteers have provided presentations in public and private schools reaching over 75,000 students and more than 6,000 teachers and administrators. The Foundation has educated approximately 100,000 children, families and community members about the dangers of the sun, and the techniques to prevent skin cancer and to detect this disease early. Melanoma and other skin cancers are almost 100 percent preventable and curable if detected and treated early, and the Foundation's goal is to educate the public on this issue.

The Foundation has agreed to supply sunscreen and a sunscreen dispenser for a pilot program at the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department's (PROS) Westwind Lakes Park. The dispenser was installed on April 23, 2019 at an event with the Foundation and is being used by park patrons. PROS staff will provide information on melanoma to park patrons as part of an ongoing informational campaign.





RESOLUTION NO. R-920-18

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO ESTABLISH A FREE SUNSCREEN DISPENSER PILOT PROJECT SPONSORED BY THE RICHARD DAVID KANN MELANOMA FOUNDATION AT WESTWIND LAKES PARK, TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY AGREEMENTS FOR THIS PILOT PROJECT, TO EXERCISE ANY PROVISIONS CONTAINED THEREIN, AND TO SUBMIT A WRITTEN REPORT TO THE BOARD

WHEREAS, skin cancer, which can be caused by too much exposure to the sun, is the most common of all cancers, and skin cancer rates have risen over the past few decades; and

WHEREAS, Florida is second only behind California in incidence of melanoma, a deadly form of skin cancer; and

WHEREAS, sunscreen helps prevent sunburn and reduces the risk of skin cancer; and

WHEREAS, Westwind Lakes Park has a variety of outdoor amenities for adults and children, including a skateboard park, and the use of the recreational facilities at Westwind Lakes Park may result in sun exposure; and

WHEREAS, the availability of free sunscreen would encourage the use of sunscreen, and would assist in educating park users regarding the importance of sunscreen use; and

WHEREAS, the Richard David Kann Melanoma Foundation, a non-profit organization focused on the prevention of melanoma, located in West Palm Beach, FL has agreed to supply sunscreen and sunscreen dispensers for use at Westwind Lakes; and

WHEREAS, other municipalities including Miami Beach, and the City of Miami have established similar programs; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of a pilot project would allow this Board to evaluate the effectiveness of the program,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Incorporates and approves the above recitals as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to establish a pilot project whereby the Richard David Kann Melanoma Foundation shall install a free sunscreen dispenser or dispensers at Westwind Lakes Park, to execute any necessary agreements for this pilot project subject to approval for form and legal sufficiency by the County Attorney's Office, and to exercise any provisions contained therein.

Section 3. Directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to provide a written report to the Board regarding the directives set forth in Section 2 of this resolution within 6 months of the effective date of this resolution, which shall be placed on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Joe A. Martinez. It was offered by Commissioner Rebeca Sosa, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sally A. Heyman and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
