Recommendation for Approval to Exercise the Option to Renew Term under Contract

No. L7217-1/24, Vegasoft Software Maintenance and Support

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) authorize the County Mayor or Mayor's Designee to exercise the five-year option to renew term under *Contract No. L7217-1/24 Vegasoft Software Maintenance and Support.* The initial five-year term was awarded to Vegasoft Oy, the software's sole proprietor, under the County Mayor's delegated authority. Board approval of this legacy contract, as well as the option to renew terms, is required as the value of the requested renewal term exceeds the County Mayor's delegated authority.

The software allows data from various mainframe applications to be accessed via the internet, allowing County staff and citizens to view information and make payments for taxes and fees. Some of the 498 applications accessed via Vegasoft software include: Building and Zoning System, Code Enforcement System, Clerk's Financial System, Criminal Justice System, Inmate Profile System, Parking Violation System, Traffic Information System, Value Adjustment Board System, Property Tax Assessment System, and Waste Collection System.

Vegasoft Oy is the sole proprietor of the software, maintenance, and support services. There are no other vendors authorized or certified to provide service for the software. As the County continues to modernize the software application portfolio and move away from mainframe applications, reliance on this software will be reduced or eliminated. Accordingly, it is in the County's best interest to exercise the available option to renew term to continue purchasing the necessary maintenance and support services for the existing system.

Scope

The scope of this item is countywide in nature.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The contract is in its initial term and expires on October 31, 2019. If the option to renew term is exercised, at the County's discretion, the contract will expire on October 31, 2024.

Due Diligence

Pursuant to Resolution No. R-187-12, due diligence was conducted in accordance with the Internal Services Department's Procurement Guidelines to determine contractor responsibility, including verifying corporate status and that there are no performance or compliance issues various vendor responsibility lists and a keyword internet search. The lists referenced included convicted vendors, debarred vendors, delinquent contractors, suspended vendors, and federal excluded parties. There were no adverse findings relating to contractor responsibility.

Pursuant to Resolution No. R-98-12, staff contacted the vendor to negotiate a reduction in pricing for the option to renew term. Those efforts resulted in the vendor holding the pre-negotiated pricing established at the contract's inception.
