Resolution Approving the Plat of Bright Homes

Recommendation

The following plat is submitted for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners (Board) for approval. This plat for Bright Homes is bounded northeasterly and easterly by the Black Creek Canal, on the south by SW 200 Street, and on the west approximately 130 feet east of SW 132 Place.

The Miami-Dade County Plat Committee recommends approval of this plat. The Plat Committee is comprised of representatives from:

- Florida Department of Transportation:

- Miami-Dade County School Board; and
- Miami-Dade County Departments of Fire Rescue; Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces; Regulatory and Economic Resources; Transportation and Public Works; and Water and Sewer.

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 16-73, this quasi-judicial matter may be submitted directly for placement on the Board's meeting agenda by the Director of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

Full scale copy of the plat and legal description of the boundaries of the land being subdivided, as well as the plat restrictions contained therein, are on file with the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

Scope

This plat is located in Commission District 8, which is represented by Commissioner Daniella Levine Cava.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

If this plat is approved, the fiscal impact to the County would be approximately \$1,300.00 annually for new roadway construction within the project. These costs would be covered by the Department of Transportation and Public Works' annual General Fund allocation.

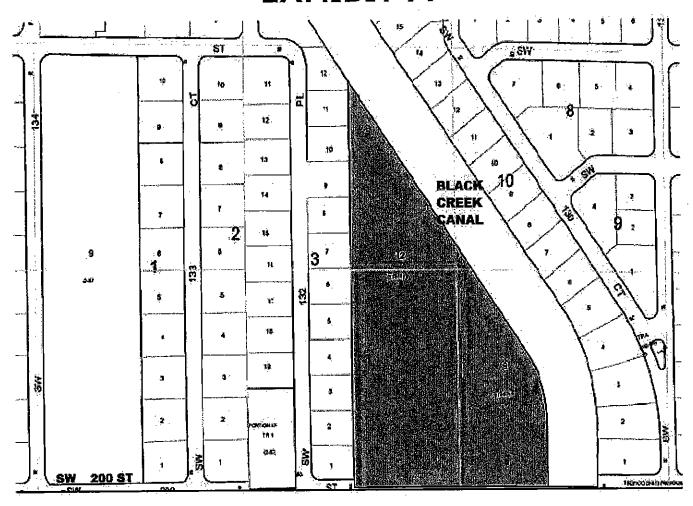

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLAT OF BRIGHT HOMES, LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWEST AND SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 2, TOWNSHIP 56 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST (BOUNDED NORTHEASTERLY AND EASTERLY BY BLACK CREEK CANAL, ON THE SOUTH BY SW 200 STREET, AND ON THE WEST APPROXIMATELY 130 FEET EAST OF SW 132 PLACE)

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, D.R. Horton, Inc., a Delaware corporation, has this day presented to this Board a plat of certain lands lying in Miami-Dade County, Florida, said plat to be known as Bright Homes, the same being a replat of a portion of Lot 9 and a portion of Lot 12, of "Tropico", according to the plat thereof, as recorded in Plat Book 2, at Page 57 of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, lying and being in the Southwest and Southeast 1/4 of Section 2, Township 56 South, Range 39 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida, and it appears that all requirements of law concerning said plat insofar as the authority of this Board is concerned have been complied with,
