Rapid Transit (BERT) Route (Route 175), on or before November 17, 2019

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the addition of a new bus route, the Northwest Miami Dade Bus Express Rapid Transit (BERT) Route (Route 175), to be implemented on or before November 17, 2019. Board approval of this proposed new bus route is required pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code (County Code), Chapter 2, Article XIX, Section 2-150, following a public hearing.

SCOPE

The proposed service adjustment will have a countywide impact.

FISCAL IMPACT

The estimated annual operating cost for the new Northwest Miami Dade BERT (Route 175) is \$965,430.00, with the first six months funded 100 percent (100%) by a \$500,000.00 grant from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) previously approved by the Board in Resolution No. R-1210-18. FDOT has programmed additional funding in its Five-Year Work Program (2020-2024) to cover future costs of this service. The additional funding will be available beginning July 1, 2019. There is no fiscal impact to the County.

TRACK RECORD/MONITOR

The Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) project manager, Carlos Cruz-Casas, P.E., Assistant Director DTPW will be responsible for this bus service change.

BACKGROUND

The Northwest Miami Dade BERT Route (Route 175) will be the first BERT route to be implemented out of a countywide network of BERT routes. It will link the newly constructed I-75/Miami Gardens Drive park-and-ride lot with the Palmetto Metrorail Station and utilize the newly constructed express lanes on I-75 and the Palmetto Expressway. The service will operate weekdays up to 10-minute frequency from 5:30 am to 9:30 am and 3:00 pm to 7:30 pm. A map of the route can be found in Attachment A.

The BERT route network is a part of the Strategic Miami Area Rapid Transit (SMART) Plan which has been previously endorsed by the Board (Resolution No. R-523-16). As mentioned in the fiscal Honorable Chairwoman Audrey M. Edmonson and Members, Board of County Commissioners Page 2

impact section of this memo, the Board has previously approved State grant funding for this route (Resolution No. R-1210-18).

All regulatory requirements will be completed in accordance with federal, state, and local law. A Title VI Analysis has determined that there are no adverse impacts on the protected population as a result of the proposed service modifications. Whenever major service adjustments occur, a comprehensive marketing campaign to inform all riders is initiated. Some of those activities include sending press releases to all major newspapers, posting service changes on the County's website, and posting rider notices on all impacted bus routes and Metrorail cars. The adjustments reflected above are enhancements to transit services.
