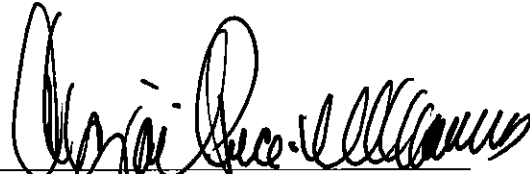

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF NW
87TH AVENUE BETWEEN NW 170TH STREET AND NW
186TH STREET AS “SGT. LARRY E. MARRERO DRIVE”

WHEREAS, Sergeant Larry E. Marrero died in the line of duty on November 28, 2018, after he suffered a heart attack while participating in his agency’s physical fitness program; and

WHEREAS, at the time of his passing, Sergeant Larry E. Marrero was posthumously promoted from the rank of Detective to Sergeant; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Larry E. Marrero served the Miami Beach Police Department for 28 years; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Larry E. Marrero served with distinction in a variety of assignments including patrol, marine patrol, school resource officer, and homicide detective, and was a twenty year member of the department’s SWAT unit; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Larry E. Marrero was a resident of Palm Springs North; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Sergeant Larry E. Marrero by codesignating that portion of NW 87th Avenue between NW 170th Street and NW 186th Street as “Sgt. Larry E. Marrero Drive”; and

WHEREAS, that portion of NW 87th Avenue between NW 170th Street and NW 186th Street is a County-maintained road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 13,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered the matter at a public hearing, codesignates that portion of NW 87th Avenue between NW 170th Street and NW 186th Street as “Sgt. Larry E. Marrero Drive”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Esteban L. Bovo, Jr. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
