Recommendation

This Recommendation for Award for Construction Services for the State Road (SR) 836 Express Bus Services - Park and Ride/Bus Terminal (Tamiami Station), Contract Number: CIP097-DTPW18-CT1 to JVA Engineering Contractor Inc. (JVA) in the amount of \$10,914,740.76 has been prepared by the Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) and is recommended for approval by the Board of County Commissioners (Board).

This contract award recommendation is placed for Board review pursuant to the Code of Miami-Dade County (Code) Section 29-124(f). This contract award recommendation may only be considered by the Board if the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has forwarded a recommendation to the Board prior to the date scheduled for Board consideration or 45 days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this contract award recommendation. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and 45 days have not elapsed since the filing of this award recommendation, I will request a withdrawal of this item.

Delegation of Authority

The authority of the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute and implement this contract is consistent with those authorities granted under the Code. No further delegation is necessary for this contract.

EXPLANATION:

DTPW advertised the project for construction services for the State Road 836 Express Bus Services – Park and Ride/Bus Terminal (Tamiami Station) on March 19, 2019. Five bids were received on April 30, 2019. The base bid amounts ranged between \$10,347,824.50 and \$11,982,559.18 (exclusive of allowance accounts). The low bid submitted by JVA is 8.16% above the Engineer of Record's (EOR) estimate.

DTPW staff conducted an extensive review of the bids received. In addition to pricing, bids were reviewed based on the bidders' licensing, local, federal and state requirements, past experience, and ability to construct projects of similar size and scope, as described in the project's Summary of Work.

In addition, on July 16, 2019, DTPW's Office of Civil Rights concluded its review of the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) requirements submitted by JVA and they were found to be in compliance with the DBE requirements established for the project. In accordance with DTPW's Standard Operating Procedures, all applicable FTA requirements have been included and certified by DTPW staff. JVA has 53 evaluations in the Capital Improvements Information System with an average rating of 3.6 points out of a possible 4.0 points. In addition, JVA's principal has indicated 16 years of experience as a general contractor in construction work similar to the work for this contract. Finally, DTPW staff and the EOR reviewed the business references included in JVA's bid package and deemed their experience for projects similar in size and complexity satisfactory.

As a result, DTPW found JVA, the lowest bidder, to be responsive and responsible to all bid requirements, with a total award price of \$10,914,740.76 (inclusive of base for \$10,347,824.50, 5.00% Contingency Allowance Account for \$517,391.23 and a Dedicated Allowance Account for Art in Public Places for \$49,525.03; refer to the attached Art in Public Places Allocation Worksheet). Therefore, DTPW recommends that this contract be awarded to JVA.

DUE DILIGENCE:

Due diligence was conducted in accordance with the Internal Services Department's (ISD) and DTPW's Procurement Guidelines to determine contractor responsibility, including verifying corporate status. The lists that were referenced include: Sun Biz, Dun & Bradstreet, Convicted Vendors, Delinquent Contractors, Suspended Vendors, Florida Suspended Contractors, System for Award Management, federal excluded parties, Scrutinized Companies, Debarred Contractors, Goal Deficit Make-Up Report and ISD's Division of Small Business Development's (SBD) Violations report. JVA was found to be listed on the SBD Violations report with three closed violations (report attached). There were no adverse findings related to contractor responsibility.

In addition, due diligence was conducted in accordance with Directive No. 182536 by DTPW's Office of Safety and Security to determine contractor responsibility, including verifying corporate safety records. The contractor and first-tier subcontractors' safety

records were considered and there were no adverse findings related to contractor responsibility. This information is being provided pursuant to Resolution No. R-1181-18.

Payments on account will be made as provided for in the Contract Documents.

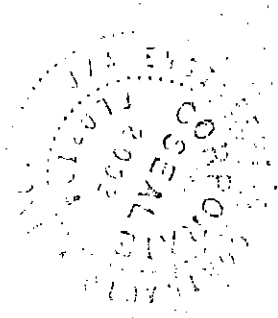

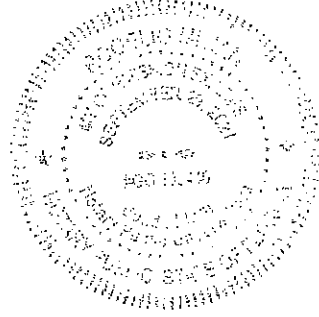
